- Ephesians 4:1 (AV) I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,
- Genesis 6 Referred to God dealing with sin.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

- Strongs #3153 mataiotes *mat-ah-yot'-ace* AV-vanity 3; 1) what is devoid of truth and appropriateness 2) perverseness, depravity 3) frailty, want of vigour.
- Romans 8:20 For the creature was made subject to vanity <3153>, not willingly, but by reason of Him Who hath subjected *the same* in hope,
- 1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it; Ephesians 4:17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth

- Ephesians 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

- Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 18:37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a King. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth My voice. 38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in Him no fault at all.
- Ephesians 4:26 (AV) Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

- Ephesians 4:28 (AV) Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with *his* hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. Ephesians 4:28 (NKJV) Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.

Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.

- Ephesians 4:29 (AV) Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

 Ephesians 4:29 (NKJV) Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.
- James 3 Referred to James teachings on the trouble with the tongue.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Ephesians 4:30 (AV) And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Ephesians 4:30 (NKJV) And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by Whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- Ephesians 4:31 (AV) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

- Ephesians 4:32 (NKJV) And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
