- Acts 19:35 And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, Ye men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the image which fell down from Jupiter?
- Acts 19:1,10 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, 10 And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the Word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.
- Referred to the relationship of the husband & wife being a symbol the relationship of Christ & the Church.

Ephesians 5:21-33 (AV) & (NKJV)

Ephesians 5:21 (AV) Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Ephesians 5:21 (NKJV) submitting to one another in the fear of God.

- Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Referred to the devil trying to take God's throne & God tossing him out of heaven.
- Strongs #5293 hupotasso *hoop-ot-as'-so* AV-put under 6, be subject unto 6, be subject to 5, submit (one's) self unto 5, submit (one's) self to 3, be in subjection unto 2, put in subjection under 1, misc 12; 40 1) to arrange under, to subordinate 2) to subject, put in subjection 3) to subject one's self, obey 4) to submit to one's control 5) to yield to one's admonition or advice 6) to obey, be subject A Greek military term meaning "to arrange troop divisions in a military fashion under the command of a leader". In non-military use, it was "a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden".
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Judges 6 Referred to Gideon testing if it really was God.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
- Genesis 20:11 And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the <u>fear of God</u> is not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.
- Genesis 20:2 And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.
- 2 Samuel 23:3 The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that

- ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God.
- 2 Chronicles 20:29 And the <u>fear of God</u> was on all the kingdoms of *those* countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel.
- Nehemiah 5:15 But the former governors that *had been* before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the <u>fear of God</u>.
- Psalms 36:1 « To the chief Musician, *A Psalm* of David the servant of the LORD. » The transgression of the wicked saith within my heart, *that there is* no fear of God before his eyes.
- Daniel 5 Referred to God dealing with Belshazzar.
- Romans 3:18 There is no fear of God before their eyes.
- 2 Corinthians 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting Holiness in the fear of God.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Ephesians 5:21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the <u>fear of God</u>.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Referred to the Husband & the wife as the CEO & the Executive Assistant. Ephesians 5:22 (AV) Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.
- Ephesians 5:22 (NKJV) Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 7:32-34 But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord: 33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife. 34 There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be Holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.
- **Proverbs 31:10-31 Summarized of the Virtuous Woman.**
- Proverbs 31:10-12 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies. 11 The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. 12 She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life.

- Ephesians 5:23 (AV) For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and He is the saviour of the body.
- Ephesians 5:23 (NKJV) For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.
- God did not make woman from a hair to rule over Adam. God did not make woman from a toe-nail for Adam to rule over her. God made woman from a rib near Adam's heart to love her & work together beside her.
- Ephesians 5:24 (AV) Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing.
- Ephesians 5:24 (NKJV) Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in everything.
- Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Ephesians 5:25 (AV) Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave Himself for it;
- Ephesians 5:25 (NKJV) Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her,
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Ephesians 5:26 (AV) That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word,
- Ephesians 5:26 (NKJV) that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the Word,
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.
- Isaiah 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.

And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat. 14 And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: 15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. 16 Unto the woman He said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee (for protection).

1 Corinthians 11:10 For this cause ought the woman to have power on her head because of the (evil) angels.

Genesis 3:17-19 And unto Adam He said, Because thou hast hearkened unto

the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life; 18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; 19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto dust shalt thou return.

- 1 Timothy 2:15 Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and Holiness with sobriety.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

Proverbs 31:13-31 She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands. 14 She is like the merchants' ships; she bringeth her food from afar. 15 She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens. 16 She considereth a field, and buyeth it: with the fruit of her hands she planteth a vineyard. 17 She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms. 18 She perceiveth that her merchandise is good: her candle goeth not out by night. 19 She layeth her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff. 20 She stretcheth out her hand to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth her hands to the needy. 21 She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household are clothed with scarlet. 22 She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing is silk and purple. 23 Her husband is known in the gates, when he sitteth among the elders of the land. 24 She maketh fine linen, and selleth it; and delivereth girdles unto the merchant. 25 Strength and honour *are* her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come. 26 She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness. 27 She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. 28 Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband *also*, and he praiseth her. 29 Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. 30 Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.
