- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.
- Luke 4 Referred to the temptations of Jesus.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Ephesians 6:11 (AV) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- Ephesians 6:11 (NKJV) Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus rebuking the devil with the Word of God.
- Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

- Jeremiah 5:25 Your iniquities have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13,14 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it; 14 And (Saul) enquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.
- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the LORD, the LORD answered him not, neither by dreams, nor by Urim, nor by prophets.
- Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being

- made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

- 1 Samuel 14:6 And Jonathan said to the young man that bare his <u>armour</u>, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the LORD will work for us: for *there is* no restraint to the LORD to save by many or by few.
- 1 Samuel 17:41 And the Philistine came on and drew near unto David; and the man that bare the shield went before him.
- 1 Samuel 17:38,39 And Saul armed David with his <u>armour</u>, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head; also he armed him with a coat of mail. 39 And David girded his sword upon his <u>armour</u>, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved *it*. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved *them*. And David put them off him.

- Matthew 25 Referred to the five foolish virgins with no oil Holy Spirit.
- 1 Samuel 17:54 And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.
- 1 Samuel 31:9,10 And they cut off his head, and stripped off his <u>armour</u>, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to publish *it in* the house of their idols, and among the people. 10 And they put his <u>armour</u> in the house of Ashtaroth: and they fastened his body to the wall of Bethshan.

- 2 Samuel 2:21 And Abner said to him, Turn thee aside to thy right hand or to thy left, and lay thee hold on one of the young men, and take thee his <u>armour</u>. But Asahel would not turn aside from following of him.
- 2 Samuel 18:15 And ten young men that bare Joab's <u>armour</u> compassed about and smote Absalom, and slew him.
- 1 Kings 10:25 And they brought every man his present, vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and garments, and <u>armour</u>, and spices, horses, and mules, a rate year by year.
- 1 Kings 22:38 And *one* washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria; and the dogs licked up his blood; and they washed his <u>armour</u>; according unto the Word of the LORD which he spake.
- 2 Kings 3:21 And when all the Moabites heard that the kings were come up to fight against them, they gathered all that were able to put on <u>armour</u>, and upward, and stood in the border.
- 2 Kings 10:2 Now as soon as this letter cometh to you, seeing your master's sons are with you, and there are with you chariots and horses, a fenced city also, and armour;
- 2 Kings 20:13,17 And Hezekiah hearkened unto them, and shewed them all the house of his precious things, the silver, and the gold, and the spices, and the precious ointment, and *all* the house of his <u>armour</u>, and all that was found in his treasures: there was nothing in his house, nor in all his dominion, that Hezekiah shewed them not. 17 Behold, the days come, that all that is in thine house, and that which thy fathers have laid up in store unto this day, shall be carried into Babylon: nothing shall be left, saith the LORD.
- 1 Chronicles 10:9,10 And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his <u>armour</u>, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people. 10 And they put his <u>armour</u> in the house of their gods, and fastened his head in the temple of Dagon.
- Isaiah 22:8 And he discovered the covering of Judah, and thou didst look in that day to the <u>armour</u> of the house of the forest.
- Isaiah 39:2 And Hezekiah was glad of them, and shewed them the house of his precious things, the silver, and the gold, and the spices, and the precious ointment, and all the house of his <u>armour</u>, and all that was found in his treasures: there was nothing in his house, nor in all his dominion, that Hezekiah shewed them not.
- Ezekiel 38:4 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of <u>armour</u>, even a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:

- Mark 13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but My Words shall not pass away.
- Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his <u>armour</u> wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- Acts 19 Referred to the 7 sons of Sceva false exorcists.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
