Are You Really Wrestling - Ephesians 6E

- Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Ephesians 6:10,11 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

- Acts 5:39 (NKJV) but if it is of God, you cannot overthrow it; lest you even be found to <u>fight</u> against God.
- Acts 5:39 (AV) But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth.
- Matthew 7:21 Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

- Strongs #3164 machomai *makh'-om-ahee* AV-strive 3, fight 1; 4 1) to fight 1a) of armed combatants, or those who engage in a hand to hand struggle 1b) of those who engage in a war of words, to quarrel, wrangle, dispute 1c) of those who contend at law for property and privileges.
- Acts 7:26 (AV) And the next day he shewed himself unto them as they strove, and would have set them at one again, saying, Sirs, ye are brethren; why do ye wrong one to another?
- Acts 23:9 (NKJV) Then there arose a loud outcry. And the scribes of the Pharisees' party arose and protested, saying, We find no evil in this man; but if a spirit or an angel has spoken to him, let us not fight against God.
