## **The Breastplate Of Righteousness - Ephesians 6K**

Summarized of putting on all the parts of the Gospel armour.

- Luke 18 Summarized of the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican. V13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.
- 1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Ephesians 6:10-14 (AV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;
- Ephesians 6:14 (NKJV) Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,
- Ephesians 6:14 (ESV) Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,
- Ephesians 6:14 (Message) Truth, righteousness,
- 1 Samuel 17:48 And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.
- 1 Samuel 17:39 And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved it. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved them. And David put them off him.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

- Hebrews 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the LORD, the LORD answered him not, neither by dreams, nor by Urim, nor by prophets.
- 1 Chronicles 10:14 And (Saul) enquired not of the LORD: therefore He slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Strongs #2382 thorax *tho'-rax* AV-breastplate 5; 1) the breast, the part of the body from the neck to the navel, where the ribs end 2) a breastplate or corset consisting of two parts and protecting the body on both sides from the neck to the middle.
- 1 Kings 22:34 Now a certain man drew a bow at random, and struck the king of Israel between the joints of his armor. So he said to the driver of his chariot, Turn around and take me out of the battle, for I am wounded.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Strongs #1343 dikaiosune dik-ah-yos-oo'-nay AV-righteousness 92; 1) in a broad sense: state of him who is as he ought to be, righteousness, the condition acceptable to God 1a) the doctrine concerning the way in which man may attain a state approved of God 1b) integrity, virtue, purity of life, rightness, correctness of thinking, feeling, and acting 2) in a narrower sense, justice or the virtue which gives each his due.
- Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Matthew 3:15 And <u>Jesus</u> answering said unto him, Suffer *it to be so* now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered Him.
- Compaired Jesus' baptism to the High priest's initiation washing.
- Matthew 3:16 And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, Io, the heavens were opened unto Him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: 17 And Io a voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.
- Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of <u>God</u>, and His <u>righteousness</u>; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Matthew 5 Referred to the Beatitudes the new covenant comparable to the old covenant 10 Commandments.
- Matthew 25:37 Then shall the <u>righteous</u> answer Him, saying, <u>Lord</u>, when saw we Thee an hungred, and fed *Thee*? or thirsty, and gave *Thee* drink?
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 25:40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.
- Mark 2:17 When <u>Jesus</u> heard *it*, He saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the <u>righteous</u>, but sinners to repentance.
- Luke 19:5 And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.
- Luke 1:6 And they were both <u>righteous</u> before <u>God</u>, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Luke 23:47 Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified <u>God</u>, saying, Certainly this was a <u>Righteous</u> Man.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what

- they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.
- Acts 13:10 (AV) And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, *thou* child of the devil, *thou* enemy of all <u>righteousness</u>, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the <u>Lord</u>?
- Acts 13:10,11 (NKJV) and said, O full of all deceit and all fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord? 11 And now, indeed, the hand of the Lord is upon you, and you shall be blind, not seeing the sun for a time. And immediately a dark mist fell on him, and he went around seeking someone to lead him by the hand.
- Romans 1:17 For therein is the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u> revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Romans 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by Lis life.
- Romans 2:5 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the <u>righteous</u> judgment of <u>God</u>;
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 3:5 But if our unrighteousness commend the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u>, what shall we say? *Is* <u>God</u> unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man)
- John 18:38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.
- Romans 3:21,22 But now the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u> without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; 22 Even the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u> which is by faith of <u>Jesus Christ</u> unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should

boast.

- Romans 3:25 Whom <u>God</u> hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in His Blood, to declare His <u>righteousness</u> for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of <u>God</u>;
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Romans 3:26 To declare, *I say*, at this time His <u>righteousness</u>: that He might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in <u>Jesus</u>.
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.
- Romans 4:3 For what saith the Scripture? Abraham believed <u>God</u>, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- Romans 4:6 Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom <u>God</u> imputeth <u>righteousness</u> without works,
- Romans 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the <u>gift of righteousness</u> shall reign in life by One, <u>Jesus Christ</u>.)
- Romans 5:21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through <u>righteousness</u> unto eternal life by <u>Jesus Christ</u> our <u>Lord</u>.
- **GRACE God's Riches At Christ's Expense.**
- Mercy Not receiving the punishment we deserve.
- 2 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 6:13 Neither yield ye your members *as* instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto <u>God</u>, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of <u>righteousness</u> unto <u>God</u>.
- John 11 Referred to Lazarus raised from the dead.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Romans 8:10 And if <u>Christ</u> *be* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin; but the Spirit *is* life because of <u>righteousness</u>.
- Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity

- every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Romans 9:28 For He will finish the work, and cut *it* short in <u>righteousness</u>: because a short work will the <u>Lord</u> make upon the earth.
- Mark 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Romans 10:3 For they being ignorant of <u>God</u>'s <u>righteousness</u>, and going about to establish their own <u>righteousness</u>, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.
- 1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.
- Romans 10:4 For <u>Christ</u> is the end of the law for <u>righteousness</u> to every one that believeth.
- Romans 10:6 But the <u>righteousness</u> which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring <u>Christ</u> down *from above*:)
- Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of <u>God</u> is not meat and drink; but <u>righteousness</u>, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.
- John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a king, He departed again into a mountain Himself alone.
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 But of Him are ye in <u>Christ Jesus</u>, Who of <u>God</u> is made unto us wisdom, and <u>righteousness</u>, and sanctification, and redemption:
- Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Isaiah 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.
- 1 Corinthians 15:34 Awake to <u>righteousness</u>, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of <u>God</u>: I speak *this* to your shame.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's

- clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Numbers 11:4 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He hath made Him *to be* sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u> in Him.
- 2 Corinthians 6:7 By the Word of Truth, by the power of <u>God</u>, by the <u>armour of righteousness</u> on the right hand and on the left,
- Galatians 2:21 I do not frustrate the grace of <u>God</u>: for if <u>righteousness</u> <u>come</u> by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.
- Galatians 3:6 Even as Abraham believed <u>God</u>, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- Galatians 3:21 *Is* the law then against the promises of <u>God</u>? <u>God</u> forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily <u>righteousness</u> should have been by the law.
- Ephesians 4:24 And that ye put on the new man, which after <u>God</u> is created in righteousness and true Holiness.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the <u>fruits of righteousness</u>, which are by <u>Jesus Christ</u>, unto the glory and praise of <u>God</u>.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Philippians 3:9 And be found in Him, not having mine own <u>righteousness</u>, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of <u>Christ</u>, the <u>righteousness</u> which is of <u>God</u> by faith:
- 2 Thessalonians 1:5,6 *Which is* a manifest token of the <u>righteous</u> judgment of <u>God</u>, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of <u>God</u>, for which ye also suffer: 6 Seeing *it is* a <u>righteous</u> thing with <u>God</u> to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;
- 1 Timothy 6:11 But thou, O man of <u>God</u>, flee these things; and follow after <u>righteousness</u>, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow <u>righteousness</u>, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the <u>Lord</u> out of a pure heart.
- 2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of <u>God</u>, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in <u>righteousness</u>:
- 2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of <u>righteousness</u>, which the <u>Lord</u>, the <u>righteous</u> judge, shall give me at that day: and not to

- me only, but unto all them also that love His appearing.
- Hebrews 1:8,9 But unto the Son *He saith*, Thy throne, O <u>God</u>, *is* for ever and ever: a sceptre of <u>righteousness</u> *is* the sceptre of Thy kingdom. 9 Thou hast loved <u>righteousness</u>, and hated iniquity; therefore <u>God</u>, *even* Thy <u>God</u>, hath anointed Thee with the oil of gladness above Thy fellows.
- Hebrews 11:4 By faith Abel offered unto <u>God</u> a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was <u>righteous</u>, <u>God</u> testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.
- Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of <u>God</u> of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the <u>righteousness</u> which is by faith.
- James 1:20 For the wrath of man worketh not the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u>.
- James 2:23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed <u>God</u>, and it was imputed unto him for <u>righteousness</u>: and he was called the Friend of God.
- 1 Peter 3:12 For the eyes of the <u>Lord</u> *are* over the <u>righteous</u>, and His ears *are open* unto their prayers: but the face of the <u>Lord</u> *is* against them that do evil.
- 2 Peter 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the <u>righteousness</u> of <u>God</u> and our Saviour <u>Jesus Christ</u>:
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, <u>Jesus Christ</u> the righteous:
- 1 John 3:10 In this the children of <u>God</u> are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not <u>righteousness</u> is not of <u>God</u>, neither he that loveth not his brother.
- Revelation 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art <u>righteous</u>, O <u>Lord</u>, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because Thou hast judged thus.
- Revelation 16:7 And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, <u>Lord God</u> Almighty, true and <u>righteous</u> *are* Thy judgments.
