## **Are Your Feet Shod - Ephesians 6L**

- Ephesians 6:10-14 (AV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
- Acts 10:36 The Word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (He is Lord of all:)
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.
- John 11:43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Ephesians 6:15 (AV) And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
- Ephesians 6:15 (NKJV) and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
- Ephesians 6:15 (ESV) and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.
- John 2:17 Then His disciples remembered that it was written, Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up.
- James 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
- Ephesians 6:15 (Message) peace,

- Galatians 1:17,18 Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.
- Strongs #2098 euaggelion yoo-ang-ghel'-ee-on AV-gospel 46, gospel of Christ 11, gospel of God 7, gospel of the Kingdom 3, misc 10; 77 1) a reward for good tidings 2) good tidings 2a) the glad tidings of the kingdom of God soon to be set up, and subsequently also of Jesus the Messiah, the founder of this kingdom. - 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- Summarized of the false peace of Pax Romana in this era.

- John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- Strongs #4623 siopao see-o-pah'-o AV-hold (one's) peace 9, peace 1, dumb 1; 11 1) to be silent, hold one's peace 1a) used of one's silence because dumb 2) metaph. of a calm, quiet sea.
- Mark 1:24,25 Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God. 25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.

- peace, and be healed of your affliction.
- Mark 9:50 Salt *is* good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have <u>peace</u> with one another.
- Luke 1:79 To give Light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, To guide our feet into the way of peace.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Summarized of Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, And on earth <u>peace</u>, goodwill toward men!
- Summarized of the many ways the devil stirred up trouble trying to kill Jesus when He first came to earth.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Luke 2:29 Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in <u>peace</u>, According to Your Word;
- Luke 7:50 Then He said to the woman, Your faith has saved you. Go in <u>peace</u>.
- Luke 8:48 And He said to her, Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in <u>peace</u>.
- Luke 10:5,6 But whatever house you enter, first say, <u>Peace</u> to this house. 6 And if a son of <u>peace</u> is there, your <u>peace</u> will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.
- Luke 11:21 When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he comes upon him and overcomes him, he takes from him all his armor in which he trusted, and divides his spoils.
- Luke 12:51 Do *you* suppose that I came to give <u>peace</u> on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division.
- Luke 14:32 Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of <u>peace</u>.
- Luke 19:38 saying: Blessed is the King Who comes in the Name of the

- **LORD!** Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!
- Luke 19:42 saying, If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things *that make* for your <u>peace!</u> But now they are hidden from your eyes.
- Matthew 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!
- Luke 23:21 But they shouted, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him!
- Luke 24:36 Now as they said these things, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said to them, <u>Peace</u> to you.
- John 14:27 <u>Peace</u> I leave with you, My <u>peace</u> I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
