The Shield Of Faith - Ephesians 6M

- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Ephesians 6:10-14 (AV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- Ephesians 6:16 (NKJV) above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.
- Ephesians 6:16 (ESV) In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one;
- Ephesians 6:16 (Message) faith,
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (miss-used by prosperity teachings)
- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, <u>Increase</u> our <u>faith</u>.
- Luke 11:1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, one of His disciples said unto Him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

- Judges 7 Referred to Gideon testing if it really was God.
- Galatians 3:6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Job 1&2 Summarized of the testings of Job.
- Job 2:9,10 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. 10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.

- 1 Samuel 17:39 And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved it. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved them. And David put them off him.
- 1 Samuel 9:2 And he had a son, whose name was Saul, a choice young man, and a goodly: and there was not among the children of Israel a goodlier person than he: from his shoulders and upward he was higher than any of the people.
- 1 Samuel 17:36 Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the Living God.
- 1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the Name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.
- Psalms 3:3 But Thou, O LORD, art a Shield for me; my Glory, and the lifter up

of mine head.

Psalms 5:12 For Thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt Thou compass him as *with* a Shield.

Matthew 5 Referred to the Beatitudes.

- Psalms 18:35 Thou hast also given me the Shield of Thy Salvation: and Thy right hand hath holden me up, and Thy gentleness hath made me great.
- Matthew 7:21,23 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine Own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.

- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

1 Samuel 13 Summarized of Samuel planning to come do the offering. V9 And

- Saul said, Bring hither a burnt offering to me, and peace offerings. And he offered the burnt offering.
- Psalms 35:2 Take hold of shield and buckler, and stand up for mine help.
- Psalms 59:11 Slay them not, lest my people forget: scatter them by Thy power; and bring them down, O Lord our shield.
- 2 Chronicles 20:22 And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.
- Psalms 76:3 There brake he the arrows of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah.
- 2 Chronicles 32:8 With him *is* an arm of flesh; but with us *is* the LORD our God to help us, and to fight our battles. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.
- Deuteronomy 17:17-19 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. 18 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this Law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the Words of this Law and these statutes, to do them:
- Psalms 84:9 Behold, O God our Shield, and look upon the face of Thine anointed.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate Me;
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Psalms 84:11 For the LORD God *is* a Sun and Shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good *thing* will He withhold from them that walk uprightly.

- Psalms 91:4 He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth *shall be thy* Shield and Buckler.
- Luke 13:34 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- 1 Corinthians 9:5 Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas? (Miss-used) Leviticus 18&20 Referred to God's laes on morality.
- Psalms 115:9-11 O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: He *is* their Help and their Shield. 10 O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: He *is* their Help and their Shield. 11 Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: He *is* their Help and their Shield.
- Psalms 119:114 Thou art my Hiding Place and my Shield: I hope in Thy Word.
- Psalms 144:2 My Goodness, and my Fortress; my High Tower, and my Deliverer; my Shield, and *He* in Whom I trust; Who subdueth my people under me.
- Proverbs 30:5 Every Word of God *is* pure: He *is* a Shield unto them that put their trust in him.
- Matthew 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have <u>faith as a grain of mustard seed</u>, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.
- Matthew 21:21 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.
- John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
- Luke 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; Referred to the persistant widow.
