The Sword Of The Spirit - Ephesians 6P

- Jeremiah 17:5 Thus saith the LORD; Cursed *be* the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD.
- Ephesians 6:10-17 (AV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:
- Luke 22:36,38 Then said He unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one. 38 And they said, Lord, behold, here are two swords. And He said unto them, It is enough.
- John 18:10,11 Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus. 11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?
- Luke 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word of God.
- Revelation 19:15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.

- Ephesians 6:17 (Message) and salvation are more than words. Learn how to

- Strongs #3162 machaira *makh'-ahee-rah* AV-sword 29; 1) a large knife, used for killing animals and cutting up flesh 2) a small sword, as distinguished from a large sword 2a) curved sword, for a cutting stroke 2b) a straight sword, for thrusting.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Mark 16:15-20 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Hebrews 4:12 (AV) For the Word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) For the Word of God *is* living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Referred to our Spiritual Armour as based on our relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.

- Acts 15:10,20 Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Luke 14:26 If any man come to Me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- Leviticus 18&20 Referred to God's laws on Morality.
- Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 1 Samuel 9:27 *And* as they were going down to the end of the city, Samuel said to Saul, Bid the servant pass on before us, (and he passed on,) but stand thou still a while, that I may shew thee the <u>Word of God</u>.
- 1 Samuel 8:5 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations.
- Summarized of Samuel growing up among sinful priests & the first king.
- 1 Kings 12:22 But the <u>Word of God</u> came unto Shemaiah the man of God, saying,
- 1 Kings 22:6-8 Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets (of Baal) together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, Go up; for the Lord shall deliver it into the hand of the king. 7 And Jehoshaphat said, Is there not here a prophet of the LORD besides, that we might enquire of him? 8 And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may enquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so.
- 1 Chronicles 17:3 And it came to pass the same night, that the <u>Word of God</u> came to Nathan, saying,
- Summarized of David's sin with Bathsheba.
- 2 Samuel 12:7,14 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul; 14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

- Proverbs 30:5 Every <u>Word of God</u> is pure: He is a Shield unto them that put their trust in Him.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Mark 7:13 Making the <u>Word of God</u> of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Luke 3:2 Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the <u>Word of God</u> came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 4:3 And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. 4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every <u>Word of God</u>.
- John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 5:1 And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon Him to hear the <u>Word of God</u>, He stood by the lake of Gennesaret,
- Matthew 15:32 Then Jesus called his disciples unto him, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.
- Luke 8:21 And He answered and said unto them, My mother and My brethren are these which hear the <u>Word of God</u>, and do it.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Luke 11:28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed *are* they that hear the <u>Word of God</u>, and keep it.
- John 10:35 If He called them gods, unto whom the <u>Word of God</u> came, and the Scripture cannot be broken;
- Luke 17:14 And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.
- Leviticus 14:3 And the priest shall go forth out of the camp; and the priest

- shall look, and, behold, if the plague of leprosy be healed in the leper;
- Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the <u>Word of God</u> with boldness.
- Acts 6:2 Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples *unto them*, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the <u>Word of God</u>, and serve tables.
- Deuteronomy 17:18,19 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this Law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the Words of this Law and these statutes, to do them:
- 2 Kings 22:8,11 And Hilkiah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it. 11 And it came to pass, when the king had heard the words of the book of the law, that he rent his clothes.
- Acts 6:7 And the <u>Word of God</u> increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.
- Acts 8:14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the <u>Word of God</u>, they sent unto them Peter and John:
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Acts 11:1 And the apostles and brethren that were in Judaea heard that the Gentiles had also received the <u>Word of God</u>.
- Acts 12:24 But the Word of God grew and multiplied.
- Acts 13:5 And when they were at Salamis, they preached the <u>Word of God</u> in the synagogues of the Jews: and they had also John to *their* minister.
- Acts 13:7 Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the Word of God.
- Acts 13:44,46 And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the <u>Word of God</u>. 46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the <u>Word of God</u> should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.
- Acts 17:13 But when the Jews of Thessalonica had knowledge that the <u>Word of God</u> was preached of Paul at Berea, they came thither also, and stirred up the people.

- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Acts 18:11 And he continued *there* a year and six months, teaching the <u>Word of God</u> among them.
- Acts 19:20 So mightily grew the Word of God and prevailed.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Hebrews 4:12 For the <u>Word of God</u> *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

More Service Notes:

- Romans 9:6 Not as though the <u>Word of God</u> hath taken none effect. For they *are* not all Israel, which are of Israel:
- Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the <u>Word of</u> God.
- 1 Corinthians 14:36 What? came the <u>Word of God</u> out from you? or came it unto you only?
- 2 Corinthians 2:17 For we are not as many, which corrupt the <u>Word of God</u>: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 4:2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the <u>Word of God</u> deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
- Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the <u>Word of God</u>:
- Colossians 1:25 Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the <u>Word of God</u>;
- 1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the <u>Word of God</u> which ye heard of us, ye received *it* not *as* the word of men, but as it is in truth, the <u>Word of God</u>, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
- 1 Timothy 4:5 For it is sanctified by the Word of God and prayer.
- 2 Timothy 2:9 Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, *even* unto bonds; but the Word of God is not bound.
- Titus 2:5 *To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the <u>Word of God</u> be not blasphemed.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the <u>Word of God</u> *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and

- intents of the heart.
- Hebrews 6:5 And have tasted the good <u>Word of God</u>, and the powers of the world to come,
- Hebrews 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the <u>Word of God</u>, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.
- Hebrews 13:7 Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the <u>Word of God</u>: whose faith follow, considering the end of *their* conversation.
- 1 Peter 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- 2 Peter 3:5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the <u>Word of God</u> the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- 1 John 2:14 I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *that is* from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the <u>Word of God</u> abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.
- Revelation 1:2,9 Who bare record of the <u>Word of God</u>, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw. 9 I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the <u>Word of God</u>, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Revelation 6:9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the <u>Word of God</u>, and for the testimony which they held:
- Revelation 19:13 And He *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His Name is called The <u>Word of God</u>.
- Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the Word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
