The Plague Of False Prophets And False Teachers - 2 Peter 2A

- Nehemiah 4:11 And our adversaries said, They shall not know, neither see, till we come in the midst among them, and slay them, and cause the work to cease.
- 2 Peter 2:1 (AV) But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.
- 2 Peter 2:1 (NKJV) But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, *and* bring on themselves swift destruction.
- 1 Kings 22 Summarized of Ahab & his false prophets of Baal, & Jehosephat's affinity.
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel & the killing of all the prophets of Baal.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And He said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his (Baal) prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to David trying on Saul's armour & discarding it.
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- Deuteronomy 13:3 Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Strongs #5578 pseudoprophetes *psyoo-dop-rof-ay'-tace* AV-false prophet 11; 1) one who, acting the part of a divinely inspired prophet, utters falsehoods under the name of divine prophecies 2) a false prophet.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Strongs #5572 pseudodidaskalos *psyoo-dod-id-as'-kal-os* AV-false teacher 1; 1) a false teacher.
- Acts 8 Referred to Simon Magus sorcerer pretending to be saved.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the

saints.

- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

- 2 Peter 2:15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness:
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

- Luke 4 Jesus rebuked the devil's temptations with "It is Written..."

- Strongs #2962 kurios koo'-ree-os AV-Lord 667, lord 54, master 11, sir 6, Sir 6,

- Deuteronomy 13:5 And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death; because he hath spoken to turn you away from the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage, to thrust thee out of the way which the LORD thy God commanded thee to walk in. So shalt thou put the evil away from the midst of thee.
- Luke 8:11-15 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. 12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. 13 They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. 14 And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. 15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a

- famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:
- Numbers 16:30 But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.
- Numbers 16 Summarized of Israelites against Moses & God would judge them but Moses Interceded.
- 2 Peter 2:2 (AV) And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.
- 2 Peter 2:2 (NKJV) And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the Way of Truth will be blasphemed.
- Strongs #987 blasphemeo *blas-fay-meh'-o* AV-blaspheme 17, speak evil of 10, rail on 2, blasphemer 1, speak blasphemy 1, blasphemously 1, misc 3; 35 1) to speak reproachfully, rail at, revile, calumniate, blaspheme 2) to be evil spoken of, reviled, railed at.
- 1 John 2:18 Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.
- Acts 5:17 Then the high priest rose up, and all they that were with him, (which is the sect <139> of the Sadducees,) and were filled with indignation,
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect <139> of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command *them* to keep the law of Moses.
- Acts 24:5 For we have found this man *a* pestilent *fellow*, and a mover of sedition among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect <139> of the Nazarenes:
- Acts 24:14 But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy <139>, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:
- The Gospel of Matthew shows that Jesus Christ was the fulfilment of prophesy.
- Acts 26:5 Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect <139> of our religion I lived a Pharisee.
- Acts 28:22 But we desire to hear of thee what thou thinkest: for as concerning this sect <139>, we know that every where it is spoken against.
- 1 Corinthians 11:19 For there must be also heresies <139> among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you.
- Galatians 5:19,21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies <139>, 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I

- tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
- 2 Peter 2:1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies <139>, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.
- Luke 2:29 Lord <1203>, now lettest Thou Thy servant depart in peace, according to Thy Word:
- Acts 4:24 And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord <1203>, Thou art God, Which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:
- 1 Timothy 6:1,2 Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters <1203> worthy of all honour, that the Name of God and *His* doctrine be not blasphemed. 2 And they that have believing masters <1203>, let them not despise *them*, because they are brethren; but rather do *them* service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort.
- 2 Timothy 2:21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the Master's use <1203>, and prepared unto every good work.
- Titus 2:9 *Exhort* servants to be obedient unto their own masters <1203>, and to please *them* well in all *things*; not answering again;
- 1 Peter 2:18 Servants, *be* subject to *your* masters <1203> with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward(ungodly).
