## **Furtherance Of The Gospel - Philippians 1B**

- John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.
- Luke 8:13 They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the Word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Philippians 1:12-30 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Philippians 1:12 (AV) But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things *which happened* unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;
- Philippians 1:12 (NKJV) But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the gospel,
- Matthew 10:23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of Man be come.
- Philippians 1:13 (AV) So that my bonds in Christ are manifest in all the palace, and in all other *places*;
- Philippians 1:13 (NKJV) so that it has become evident to the whole palace guard, and to all the rest, that my chains are in Christ;
- Acts 16 Referred to Paul & Silas praising God in jail in Philippi.
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, Him declare I unto you.
- Acts 27:24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Philippians 1:14 (AV) And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
- Philippians 1:14 (NKJV) and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad,

- and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels.
- Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
- Philippians 1:15 (AV) Some indeed preach Christ even of envy and strife; and some also of good will:
- Philippians 1:15 (NKJV) Some indeed preach Christ even from envy and strife, and some also from good will:
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Acts 19 referred to Demetrius the silversmith rioting in Ephesus.
- Philippians 1:16 (AV) The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:
- Philippians 1:16 (NKJV) The former preach Christ from selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my chains;
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Philippians 1:17 (AV) But the other of love, knowing that I am set for the defence of the gospel.
- Philippians 1:17 (NKJV) but the latter out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel.
- Referred to Moses prepared for his job for God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- Acts 15 Referred to the girl with the divination spirit.
- Philippians 1:18 (AV) What then? notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in truth, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea,

- and will rejoice.
- Philippians 1:18 (NKJV) What then? Only *that* in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is preached; and in this I rejoice, yes, and will rejoice.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- 1 Corinthians 1:12 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Philippians 1:19 (AV) For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,
- Philippians 1:19 (NKJV) For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,
- Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.
- 1 Peter 3:1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the Word, they also may without the Word be won by the conversation of the wives;
- Philippians 1:20 (AV) According to my earnest expectation and *my* hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but *that* with all boldness, as always, *so* now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether *it be* by life, or by death.
- Philippians 1:20 (NKJV) according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- Philippians 1:21 (AV) For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
- Philippians 1:21 (NKJV) For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

- Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,
- Acts 16 Referred to the parable of Lazarus & the rich man.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Philippians 1:22 (AV) But if I live in the flesh, this *is* the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not.
- Philippians 1:22 (NKJV) But if *I* live on in the flesh, this *will mean* fruit from *my* labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- John 21:21,22 Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? 22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou Me.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- Philippians 1:23 (AV) For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:
- Philippians 1:23 (NKJV) For I am hard pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Luke 18:1 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Philippians 1:24 (AV) Nevertheless to abide in the flesh *is* more needful for you.
- Philippians 1:24 (NKJV) Nevertheless to remain in the flesh *is* more needful for you.
- Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.
- Philippians 1:25 (AV) And having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith;
- Philippians 1:25 (NKJV) And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith, Luke 4:9 And he brought Him to Jerusalem, and set Him on a pinnacle of

- the temple, and said unto him, If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down from hence:
- Philippians 1:26 (AV) That your rejoicing may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again.
- Philippians 1:26 (NKJV) that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again.
- Acts 27:22 And now I exhort you to be of good cheer: for there shall be no loss of any man's life among you, but of the ship.
- 2 Corinthians 2:7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow.
- Philippians 1:27 (AV) Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;
- Philippians 1:27 (NKJV) Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel,
- Referred to the many occult involvements & deities the Believers came out of.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.
- Revelation 13 referred to the ungodly one mind of the followers of the beast.
- Acts 15:37-40 And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark. 38 But Paul thought not good to take him with them, who departed from them from Pamphylia, and went not with them to the work. 39 And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus; 40 And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God.
- Philippians 1:28 (AV) And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God.
- Philippians 1:28 (NKJV) and not in any way terrified by your adversaries, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that from God.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Philippians 1:29 (AV) For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only

- to believe on Him, but also to suffer for His sake;
- Philippians 1:29 (NKJV) For to you it has been granted on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake,
- Referred to many modern places where Christians are persecuted & many martyred for their faith.
- Philippians 1:30 (AV) Having the same conflict which ye saw in me, and now hear *to be* in me.
- Philippians 1:30 (NKJV) having the same conflict which you saw in me and now hear *is* in me.
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 2:14 (AV) Now <u>thanks</u> *be* unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in <u>every</u> place.
- 2 Corinthians 2:14 (NKJV) Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
- Jeremiah 18:3 Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels.
- Jeremiah 18:6 O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the Name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by Him.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In <u>every</u> thing give <u>thanks</u>: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
