- Revelation 13 Referred to ungodly following the beast.
- Revelation 17:13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Philippians 2:1-11 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Philippians 2:1 (AV) If *there be* therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,
- Philippians 2:1 (NKJV) Therefore if *there is* any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy,
- Romans 12:18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

- Acts 16 Referred to Paul in Philippi & the encounter with the divination spirit.
- Exodus 7:12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- Isaiah 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.
- Philippians 2:4 (AV) Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.
- Philippians 2:4 (NKJV) Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.
- Referred that Jesus came as a Suffering Servant.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus coming as the Conquering King.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- 1 Corinthians 14 Referred to Paul addressing the competition of gifts with pride.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Mark 12:29-31 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. 31 And the second

- is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.

- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Mark 6:3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and he shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Acts 8 Referred to Simon Magus not saved. V21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Philippians 2:9 (AV) Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a Name which is above every name:
- Philippians 2:9 (NKJV) Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the Name which is above every name,
- Matthew 3:17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Summarized of Jesus' death & resurrection.
