- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- Psalms 78 Referred to the summary of Israel provoking God in the wilderness.
- Numbers 14:22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My voice;

- Ephesians 6:10-18 Referred to our spiritual battle. V12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.
- Mark 8:33 But when He had turned about and looked on His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.

- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

- Numbers 16 Referred to Korak & the rebels murmuring against Moses.
- Exodus 15:24 And the people <u>murmured</u> against Moses, saying, What shall we drink?
- Matthew 15:32 Then Jesus called His disciples unto him, and said, I have

- compassion on the multitude, because they continue with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.
- Exodus 16:2 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel <u>murmured</u> against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness:
- Exodus 16:7 And in the morning, then ye shall see the glory of the LORD; for that He heareth your <u>murmurings</u> against the LORD: and what *are* we, that ye <u>murmur</u> against us?
- 1 Chronicles 16:22 Saying, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm.
- Exodus 16:8 And Moses said, *This shall be*, when the LORD shall give you in the evening flesh to eat, and in the morning bread to the full; for that the LORD heareth your <u>murmurings</u> which ye <u>murmur</u> against Him: and what are we? your <u>murmurings</u> are not against us, but against the LORD.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Hebrews 5:12-14 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Exodus 16:9 And Moses spake unto Aaron, Say unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, Come near before the LORD: for He hath heard your murmurings.
- Exodus 16:12 I have heard the <u>murmurings</u> of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD your God.
- Exodus 14:11 And they said unto Moses, Because there were no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness? wherefore hast thou dealt thus with us, to carry us forth out of Egypt?
- Exodus 12:38 And a mixed multitude went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, even very much cattle.
- 1 Timothy 5:13,14 And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not. 14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none

- occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.
- Exodus 17:3 And the people thirsted there for water; and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Wherefore *is* this *that* thou hast brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?
- Numbers 13&14 Summarized of the evil report of the promised land & the people rebelled against God except Joshua & Caleb.
- Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel <u>murmured</u> against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- 1 Samuel 17 Summarized of Saul, David & Goliath.
- 1 Samuel 9:2 And he had a son, whose name was Saul, a choice young man, and a goodly: and there was not among the children of Israel a goodlier person than he: from his shoulders and upward he was higher than any of the people.
- Isaiah 36,37 Summarized of God dealing with Sinnacherib & Rabshakeh mocking God.
- Numbers 14:27 How long *shall I bear with* this evil congregation, which <u>murmur</u> against Me? I have heard the <u>murmurings</u> of the children of Israel, which they <u>murmur</u> against Me.
- Numbers 14:29,30 Your carcases shall fall in this wilderness; and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward, which have <u>murmured</u> against Me, 30 Except for Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun, you shall by no means enter the land which I swore I would make you dwell in.
- Numbers 14:36,37 And the men, which Moses sent to search the land, who returned, and made all the congregation to <u>murmur</u> against him, by bringing up a slander upon the land, 37 those very men who brought the evil report about the land, died by the plague before the LORD.
- Numbers 16:11 For which cause *both* thou and all thy company *are* gathered together against the LORD: and what *is* Aaron, that ye <u>murmur</u> against him? (Summarized of God dealing with Korah & the rebels.)
- Numbers 16:41 But on the morrow all the congregation of the children of Israel <u>murmured</u> against Moses and against Aaron, saying, Ye have killed the people of the LORD. (God plagued them again.)
- Numbers 17:5 And it shall come to pass, *that* the man's rod, whom I shall choose, shall blossom: and I will make to cease from Me the <u>murmurings</u>

- of the children of Israel, whereby they murmur against you.
- Numbers 17:8 And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds.
- Numbers 17:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and thou shalt quite take away their <u>murmurings</u> from Me, that they die not.
- Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye <u>murmured</u> in your tents, and said, Because the LORD hated us, He hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.
- Joshua 9:18 And the children of Israel smote them not, because the princes of the congregation had sworn unto them by the LORD God of Israel. And all the congregation <u>murmured</u> against the princes.
- Psalms 106:25 But <u>murmured</u> in their tents, *and* hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD.
- Isaiah 29:24 They also that erred in spirit shall come to understanding, and they that <u>murmured</u> shall learn doctrine.
- Matthew 20:11 And when they had received *it*, they <u>murmured</u> against the goodman of the house, (Summarized of the parable of the workers all paid the same.)
- Matthew 25 Referred of the parable of the Talents.
- Mark 14:5,7 For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they <u>murmured</u> against her. 7 For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always.
- Luke 5:30 But their scribes and Pharisees <u>murmured</u> against His disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?
- 2 Corinthians 7:5 For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh had no rest, but we were troubled on every side; without were fightings, within were fears.
- Luke 15:2 And the Pharisees and scribes <u>murmured</u>, saying, This Man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.
- Luke 19:7 And when they saw *it*, they all <u>murmured</u>, saying, That He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.
- John 6:41 The Jews then <u>murmured</u> at Him, because He said, I am the Bread which came down from heaven.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no

- man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- John 6:43 Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, <u>Murmur</u> not among yourselves.
- John 6:61 When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples <u>murmured</u> at it, He said unto them, Doth this offend you?
- John 7:12 And there was much <u>murmuring</u> among the people concerning Him: for some said, He is a good man: others said, Nay; but He deceiveth the people.
- John 7:32 The Pharisees heard that the people <u>murmured</u> such things concerning Him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take Him.
- Acts 6:1 And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a <u>murmuring</u> of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministration.
- 1 Corinthians 10:10 Neither <u>murmur</u> ye, as some of them also <u>murmured</u>, and were destroyed of the destroyer.
- Philippians 2:14 Do all things without murmurings and disputings:
- Jude 1:16 These are <u>murmurers</u>, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling *words*, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
