## **That Ye May Be Blameless - Philippians 2E**

- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this Man.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Philippians 2:14,15 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Philippians 2:14 (AV) Do all things without murmurings and disputings:
- Philippians 2:14 (NKJV) Do all things without complaining and disputing,
- Philippians 2:15 (AV) That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;
- Philippians 2:15 (NKJV) that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Matthew 22:37-40 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the deception & downfall of mankind.
- Luke 4 Referred to satan's temptations & Jesus replying with "it is written..."
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Psalms 140:5 The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread

- a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?
- Strongs #273 amemptos *am'-emp-tos* AV-blameless 3, unblameable 1, faultless 1; 5 1) blameless, deserving no censure, free from fault or defect.
- Luke 1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless <273>.
- Summarized of many special women who did not bear children until God's special plan, like Elizabeth & Hannah.
- Philippians 2:15 That ye may be blameless <273> and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;
- Philippians 3:5 Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; Leviticus Summarized of the laws of Cleanliness.
- Exodus 30:19 For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet thereat:
- Matthew 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Mark 12:31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.
- Mark 12:33 And to love Him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.
- Philippians 3:6 Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless <273>.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:13 (AV) To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable <273> in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:13 (NKJV) so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.
- James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
- Philippians 2:16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of

- Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.
- Hebrews 8:7 For if that first *covenant* had been faultless <273>, then should no place have been sought for the second.
- 1 John 2:2 And He is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Romans 8:30 Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.
- Genesis 44:10 And he said, Now also *let* it *be* according unto your words: he with whom it is found shall be my servant; and ye shall be <u>blameless</u>.
- Numbers 32:23 But if ye will not do so, behold, ye have sinned against the LORD: and be sure your sin will find you out.
- Joshua 2:17,18 And the men said unto her, We will be <u>blameless</u> of this thine oath which thou hast made us swear. 18 Behold, when we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.
- Exodus 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.
- Luke 14:28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?
- Judges 15:3 And Samson said concerning them, Now shall I be more <u>blameless</u> than the Philistines, though I do them a displeasure.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Matthew 12:5 Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are <u>blameless</u>?
- Matthew 12 Referred to Jesus teaching about the sabbath.
- Mark 2:27 And He said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:
- Matthew 12:10,12 And, behold, there was a man which had his hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him. 12 How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.
- 1 Corinthians 1:8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be

- blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I* pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved <u>blameless</u> unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Isaiah 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.
- Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Numbers 14:22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked Me see it:
- 1 Timothy 3:2 A bishop then must be <u>blameless</u>, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;
- 1 Timothy 3:7 Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
- Daniel 3:17,18 If it be so, our God Whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- 1 Timothy 3:10 And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being *found* <u>blameless</u>.
- Acts 6:2-4 Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the Word of God, and serve tables. 3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. 4 But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the Word.
- 1 Timothy 5:7 And these things give in charge, that they may be <u>blameless</u>.
- Titus 1:6 If any be <u>blameless</u>, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

- Titus 1:7 For a bishop must be <u>blameless</u>, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;
- 2 Peter 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of Him in peace, without spot, and blameless.
- 2 Peter 2:1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Strongs #05355 naqiy *naw-kee'* or naqiy' *naw-kee'* AV-innocent 31, guiltless 4, quit 2, blameless 2, clean 1, clear 1, exempted 1, free 1, variant 1; 44 1) clean, free from, exempt, clear, innocent 1a) free from guilt, clean, innocent 1b) free from punishment 1c) free or exempt from obligations 2) innocent.
- Strongs #338 anaitios *an-ah'-ee-tee-os* AV-blameless 1, guiltless 1; 2 1) guiltless, innocent.
- Strongs #410 anegkletos *an-eng'-klay-tos* AV-blameless 4, unreproveable 1; 5 1) that cannot be called into account, unreproveable, unaccused, blameless.
- Strongs #423 anepileptos *an-ep-eel'-ape-tos* AV-blameless 2, unrebukeable 1; 3 1) not apprehended, that cannot be laid hold of 2) that cannot be reprehended, not open to censure, irreproachable.
- Strongs #298 amometos *am-o'-may-tos* AV-without rebuke 1, blameless 1; 2
  1) that cannot be censured, blameless.
- Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
