

That Ye May Be Harmless - Philippians 2F

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Philippians 2:14-30 (AV) & (NKJV)

Philippians 2:14 (AV) Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

Philippians 2:14 (NKJV) Do all things without complaining and disputing,

Philippians 2:15 (AV) That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Philippians 2:15 (NKJV) that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,

1 Timothy 3:2,10; Titus 1:6,7 Referred to that Christian leaders be blameless.

Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell (<5020> Tartarus), and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Strong's #185 akeraios *ak-er'-ah-yos* AV-harmless 2, simple 1; 3 1) unmixed, pure as in wines or metals 2) of the mind, without a mixture of evil, free from guile, innocent, simple.

Romans 7:19,20,24 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do. 20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless <185> as doves.

2 Peter 2 Referred to Peter warning of the false prophets & false teachers.

1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

Philippians 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless <185>, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Hebrews 7:26 For such an high priest became us, *who is* holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens;

Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be Holy, for I am Holy.

1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.

Exodus 30:21 So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.

Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes,

shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels?

Referred to God dealing with Pharoah.

John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in Me.

Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

Luke 4 Summarized of the temptations of Jesus & His reply to satan.

1 Kings 18&19 Referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel & Elijah running from Jezebel's curses & God's last jobs fir Elijah.

2 Kings 9 Referred to Jezebel judged by Jehu.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Philippians 2:16 (NKJV) holding fast the Word of Life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

Luke 17:12,15,17 as He entered into a certain village, there met Him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back & with a loud voice glorified God, 17 Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine?

Philippians 2:17 (AV) Yea, and if I be offered upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I joy, and rejoice with you all.

Philippians 2:17 (NKJV) Yes, and if I am being poured out *as a drink offering* on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all.

2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "in perils" list.

Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

2 Corinthians 1:4 Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able

to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.

John 16:21 A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.

Philippians 2:18 (AV) For the same cause also do ye joy, and rejoice with me.

Philippians 2:18 (NKJV) For the same reason you also be glad and rejoice with me.

Philippians 2:19 (AV) But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state.

Philippians 2:19 (NKJV) But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state.

Philippians 2:20 (AV) For I have no man likeminded, who will naturally care for your state.

Philippians 2:20 (NKJV) For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state.

2 Timothy 1:5 When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

Philippians 2:21 (AV) For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

Philippians 2:21 (NKJV) For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 2:22 (AV) But ye know the proof of him, that, as a son with the father, he hath served with me in the gospel.

Philippians 2:22 (NKJV) But you know his proven character, that as a son with *his* father he served with me in the gospel.

Acts 16:3 Him would Paul have to go forth with him (Timothy); and took and circumcised him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek.

Philippians 2:23 (AV) Him therefore I hope to send presently, so soon as I shall see how it will go with me.

Philippians 2:23 (NKJV)

Therefore I hope to send him at once, as soon as I see how it goes with me.

Philippians 2:24 (AV) But I trust in the Lord that I also myself shall come shortly.

Philippians 2:24 (NKJV) But I trust in the Lord that I myself shall also come shortly.

Philippians 2:25 (AV) Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.

Philippians 2:25 (NKJV) Yet I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need;

Philippians 2:26 (AV) For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick.

Philippians 2:26 (NKJV) since he was longing for you all, and was distressed because you had heard that he was sick.

Philippians 2:27 (AV) For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had mercy on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

Philippians 2:27 (NKJV) For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

Philippians 2:28 (AV) I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when ye see him again, ye may rejoice, and that I may be the less sorrowful.

Philippians 2:28 (NKJV) Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful.

Philippians 2:29 (AV) Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness; and hold such in reputation:

Philippians 2:29 (NKJV) Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and hold such men in esteem;

Philippians 2:30 (AV) Because for the work of Christ he was nigh unto death, not regarding his life, to supply your lack of service toward me.

Philippians 2:30 (NKJV) because for the work of Christ he came close to death, not regarding his life, to supply what was lacking in your service toward me.

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Strong's #172 akakos *ak'-ak-os* AV-simple 1, harmless 1; 2 1) without guile or fraud, harmless, free from guilt 2) fearing no evil from others, distrusting no one.

Strong's #298 amometos *am-o'-may-tos* AV-without rebuke 1, blameless 1; 2 1) that cannot be censured, blameless.

Strong's #4646 skolios *skol-ee-os'* AV-crooked 2, untoward 1, froward 1; 4 1) crooked, curved 2) metaph. 2a) perverse, wicked 2b) unfair, surly, froward.

Strong's #1294 diastrepho *dee-as-tref'-o* AV-perverse 4, pervert 2, turn away 1; 7 1) to distort, turn aside 1a) to oppose, plot against the saving purposes and plans of God 2) to turn aside from the right path, to pervert, corrupt.
