- Philippians 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

- Matthew 13:16,17 But blessed *are* your eyes, for they see <991>: and your ears, for they hear. 17 For verily I say unto you, That many prophets and righteous *men* have desired to see *those things* which ye see <991>, and have not seen *them*; and to hear *those things* which ye hear, and have not heard *them*.
- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw <991> the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
- Matthew 14:29 And He said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.
- Matthew 15:31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw <991> the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see <991>: and they glorified the God of Israel.
- Matthew 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold <991> the face of My Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 22:16 And they sent out unto Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art true, and teachest the way of God in truth, neither carest Thou for any *man*: for Thou regardest <991> not the person of men. (Impartiality)
- Matthew 24:2,4 And Jesus said unto them, See ye <991> not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. 4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed <991> that no man deceive you.
- Genesis 24:6 And Abraham said unto him, <u>Beware</u> thou that thou bring not my son thither again.
- Exodus 23:21 <u>Beware</u> of Him, and obey His voice, provoke Him not; for He will not pardon your transgressions: for My name *is* in him.
- Deuteronomy 6:12 *Then* <u>beware</u> lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Deuteronomy 8:11 <u>Beware</u> that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:
- Deuteronomy 15:9 <u>Beware</u> that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

- Judges 13:4 Now therefore <u>beware</u>, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean *thing*:
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Judges 13:13 And the Angel of the LORD said unto Manoah, Of all that I said unto the woman let her beware.
- 2 Samuel 18:12 And the man said unto Joab, Though I should receive a thousand *shekels* of silver in mine hand, *yet* would I not put forth mine hand against the king's son: for in our hearing the king charged thee and Abishai and Ittai, saying, <u>Beware</u> that none *touch* the young man Absalom.
- 2 Kings 6:9,12 And the man of God sent unto the king of Israel, saying,

 <u>Beware</u> that thou pass not such a place; for thither the Syrians are come
 down. 12 And one of his servants said, None, my lord, O king: but Elisha,
 the prophet that is in Israel, telleth the king of Israel the words that thou
 speakest in thy bedchamber.
- Job 36:18 Because *there is* wrath, *beware* lest He take thee away with *His* stroke: then a great ransom cannot deliver thee.
- Proverbs 19:25 Smite a scorner, and the simple will <u>beware</u>: and reprove one that hath understanding, *and* he will understand knowledge.
- Isaiah 36:18 <u>Beware</u> lest Hezekiah persuade you, saying, The LORD will deliver us. Hath any of the gods of the nations delivered his land out of the hand of the king of Assyria?
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- Strongs #2965 kuon *koo'-ohn* AV-dog 5; 1) a dog 2) metaph. a man of impure mind, an impudent man.
- Matthew 7:6 Give not that which is Holy unto the dogs <2965>, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.
- Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.
- Luke 16:21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs <2965> came and licked his sores.
- Philippians 3:2 Beware of dogs <2965>, beware of evil workers, beware of the concision.
- 2 Peter 2:22 But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog <2965> is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.
- Revelation 22:15 For without are dogs <2965>, and sorcerers, and

- whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.
- Matthew 15:26,27 But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast *it* to <u>dogs</u>.
- Matthew 15:27 And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the <u>dogs</u> <2952> eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.
- Strongs #2952 kunarion koo-nar'-ee-on AV-dog 4; 1) a little dog.
- Mark 7:28 But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast *it* unto the <u>dogs</u> <2952>.
- Mark 7:28 And she answered and said unto him, Yes, Lord: yet the <u>dogs</u> <2952> under the table eat of the children's crumbs.
- Romans 14:1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.
- Exodus 22:31 And ye shall be holy men unto me: neither shall ye eat *any* flesh *that is* torn of beasts in the field; ye shall cast it to the <u>dogs</u><03661>.
- 1 Kings 14:11 Him that dieth of Jeroboam in the city shall the <u>dogs</u> eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.
- 1 Kings 16:4 Him that dieth of Baasha in the city shall the <u>dogs</u> eat; and him that dieth of his in the fields shall the fowls of the air eat.
- 1 Kings 21:19 And thou shalt speak unto him, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Hast thou killed, and also taken possession? And thou shalt speak unto him, saying, Thus saith the LORD, In the place where <u>dogs</u> licked the blood of Naboth shall dogs lick thy blood, even thine.
- 1 Kings 21:23,24 And of Jezebel also spake the LORD, saying, The <u>dogs</u> shall eat Jezebel by the wall of Jezreel.
- 1 Kings 21:24 Him that dieth of Ahab in the city the <u>dogs</u> shall eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat.
- 1 Kings 22:38 And *one* washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria; and the <u>dogs</u> licked up his blood; and they washed his armour; according unto the Word of the LORD which he spake.
- 2 Kings 9:10 And the <u>dogs</u> shall eat Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel, and *there shall be* none to bury *her*. And he opened the door, and fled.
- 2 Kings 9:36 Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This *is* the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall <u>dogs</u> eat the flesh of Jezebel:
- Job 30:1 But now *they that are* younger than I have me in derision, whose fathers I would have disdained to have set with the <u>dogs</u> of my flock.

- Psalms 22:16 For <u>dogs</u> have compassed Me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed Me: they pierced My hands and My feet.
- Mark 15:31 Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.
- Psalms 68:23 That thy foot may be dipped in the blood of *thine* enemies, *and* the tongue of thy <u>dogs</u> in the same.
- Isaiah 56:10 His watchmen *are* blind: they are all ignorant, they *are* all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.
- Ezekiel 33:6 But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Isaiah 56:11 Yea, *they are* greedy <u>dogs</u> *which* can never have enough, and they *are* shepherds *that* cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.
- Acts 8:21,23 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. 23 For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity.
- Acts 13:10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?
- Revelation 3:7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith He that is Holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (miss-used)
- Jeremiah 15:3 And I will appoint over them four kinds, saith the LORD: the sword to slay, and the <u>dogs</u> <03611> to tear, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the earth, to devour and destroy.
- Acts 15:2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
