

Stir Up Your Pure Minds - 2 Peter 3A

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Hebrews 10:20 By a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh;

2 Peter 3:1 (AV) This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

2 Peter 3:1 (NKJV) Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder),

1 Corinthians 11:24 And when He had given thanks, He brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is My body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of Me.

Strong's #1326 diegeiro *dee-eg-i'-ro* AV-awake 2, arise 2, stir up 2, raise 1; 7 1) to wake up, awaken, arouse (from sleep) 1a) of the sea, which begins to be agitated, to rise 1b) metaph. 1b1) to arouse the mind 1b2) stir up, render active.

John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Exodus 20 Referred to following the 10 Commandments to please God.

Matthew 1:24 Then Joseph being raised <1326> from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

Mark 4:38,39 And He was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake <1326> Him, and say unto Him, Master, carest Thou not that we perish? 39 And He arose <1326>, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

Luke 8:24 And they came to Him, and awoke <1326> Him, saying, Master, Master, we perish. Then He arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.

John 6:18 And the sea arose <1326> by reason of a great wind that blew.

2 Peter 1:13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir <1326> you up <1326> by putting *you* in remembrance;

2 Peter 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up <1326> your pure minds by way of remembrance:

Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth to be a Propitiation through faith in His Blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Strong's #1506 eilikrines *i-lik-ree-nace'* AV-sincere 1, pure 1; 2 1) pure, sincere, unsullied 2) found pure when unfolded and examined by the sun's light.

Philippians 1:10 That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere <1506> and without offence till the day of Christ;

2 Peter 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure <1506> minds by way of remembrance:

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them.

Exodus 35:21,26 And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, *and* they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the Holy garments. 26 And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' *hair*.

Exodus 36:2 And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put wisdom, *even* every one whose heart stirred him up to come unto the work to do it:

Numbers 24:9 (Judah) He couched, he lay down as a lion, and as a great lion: who shall stir him up? Blessed *is* he that blesseth thee, and cursed *is* he that curseth thee.

Deuteronomy 32:11 As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings:

1 Samuel 22:8 That all of you have conspired against me, and *there is* none that sheweth me that my son hath made a league with the son of Jesse, and *there is* none of you that is sorry for me, or sheweth unto me that my son hath stirred up my servant against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?

1 Samuel 26:19 Now therefore, I pray thee, let my lord the king hear the words of his servant. If the LORD have stirred thee up against me, let Him accept an offering: but if *they be* the children of men, cursed *be* they before the LORD; for they have driven me out this day from abiding in the inheritance of the LORD, saying, Go, serve other gods.

1 Kings 11:14 And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he *was* of the king's seed in Edom.

1 Kings 11:4,7,8 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father. 7 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.

1 Kings 11:23 And God stirred him up *another* adversary, Rezon the son of

Eliadah, which fled from his lord Hadadezer king of Zobah:

1 Kings 21:25 But there was none like unto Ahab, which did sell himself to work wickedness in the sight of the LORD, whom Jezebel his wife stirred up.

1 Chronicles 5:26 And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.

Leviticus 26 Referred to God's final judgement of stirring up a foreign nation against Israel.

2 Chronicles 21:16 Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that *were* near the Ethiopians:

2 Chronicles 36:22,23 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the Word of the LORD *spoken* by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and *put it* also in writing, saying, 23 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD God of heaven has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah. Who is among you of all His people? May the LORD his God be with him, and let him go up!

Isaiah 44:28 That saith of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.

Ezra 1:1 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and *put it* also in writing, saying,

Job 17:8 Upright *men* shall be astonished at this, and the innocent shall stir up himself against the hypocrite.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Job 41:10 None *is so* fierce that dare stir him up: who then is able to stand before me?

Psalms 35:23 Stir up Thyself, and awake to my judgment, *even* unto my cause, my God and my Lord.

Psalms 39:2 I was dumb with silence, I held my peace, *even* from good; and my sorrow was stirred.

Psalms 78:38 But He, *being* full of compassion, forgave *their* iniquity, and destroyed *them* not: yea, many a time turned He His anger away, and did not stir up all His wrath.

Psalms 80:2 Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh stir up Thy strength, and come *and* save us.

Proverbs 10:12 Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.

Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

Proverbs 15:18 A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but *he that is* slow to anger appeaseth strife.

Proverbs 28:25 He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Proverbs 29:22 An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.

Song of Solomon 2:7 I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake *my* love, till he please.

Song of Solomon 3:5 I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake *my* love, till he please.

Song of Solomon 8:4 I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, that ye stir not up, nor awake *my* love, until he please.

Isaiah 10:26 And the LORD of hosts shall stir up a scourge for him according to the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb: and *as* His rod *was* upon the sea, so shall He lift it up after the manner of Egypt.

Isaiah 13:17 Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and *as for* gold, they shall not delight in it.

Isaiah 14:9 Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet *thee* at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, *even* all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.

Isaiah 22:2 Thou that art full of stirs, a tumultuous city, a joyous city: thy slain *men are* not slain with the sword, nor dead in battle.

Isaiah 42:13 The LORD shall go forth as a mighty man, He shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: He shall cry, yea, roar; He shall prevail against His enemies.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

Isaiah 64:7 And *there is* none that calleth upon Thy Name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of Thee: for Thou hast hid Thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities.

Daniel 11:2 And now will I shew thee the truth. Behold, there shall stand up

yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than *they* all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia.

Daniel 11:10 But his sons shall be stirred up, and shall assemble a multitude of great forces: and *one* shall certainly come, and overflow, and pass through: then shall he return, and be stirred up, *even* to his fortress.

Daniel 11:25 And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the king of the south with a great army; and the king of the south shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Haggai 1:14 And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,

Strong's #1271 *dianoia dee-an'-oy-ah* AV-mind 9, understanding 3, imagination 1; 13 1) the mind as a faculty of understanding, feeling, desiring 2) understanding 3) mind, i.e. spirit, way of thinking and feeling 4) thoughts, either good or bad.

Matthew 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind <1271>.

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus,

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Mark 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind <1271>, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.

Luke 1:51 He hath shewed strength with His arm; He hath scattered the proud in the imagination <1271> of their hearts.

Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Luke 10:27 And He answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind <1271>; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.

Ephesians 1:18 The eyes of your understanding <1271> being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

Ephesians 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind <1271>; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Ephesians 4:18 Having the understanding <1271> darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, Who is the Image of God, should shine unto them.

John 12:46 I am come a Light into the world, that whosoever believeth on Me should not abide in darkness.

Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of

this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

Colossians 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in *your* mind <1271> by wicked works, yet now hath He reconciled

Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard Thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

Hebrews 8:10 For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put My laws into their mind <1271>, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to Me a people:

Hebrews 10:16 This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds <1271> will I write them;

1 Peter 1:13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind <1271>, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

2 Peter 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds <1271> by way of remembrance:

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding <1271>, that we may know Him that is true, and we are in Him that is true, *even* in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the True God, and eternal life.

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

Strong's #5280 hupomnesis *hoop-om'-nay-sis* AV-remembrance 2, put in remembrance 1; 3 1) a reminding 2) remembrance.

2 Timothy 1:5 When I call to remembrance <5280> the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

2 Peter 1:13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting *you* in remembrance <5280>;
