Beguiled With Enticing Words - Colossians 2A

- Hebrews 5:13,14 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Colossians 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:
- Colossians 2:1-4 (AV) & (NKJV) Colossians 2:1 (AV) For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, & *for* them at Laodicea, and *for* as many as have not seen my face in the flesh; Colossians 2:1 (NKJV) For I want you to know what a great conflict (spiritual warfare) I have for you and those in Laodicea, and *for* as many as have not seen my face in the flesh,
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Revelation 2 Referred to the letter to the Church in Laodicea.
- Colossians 2:2 (AV) That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;
- Colossians 2:2 (NKJV) that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and *attaining* to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ,
- Acts 16 Referred to the conflict & expulsion of the Pithon divination spirit.
- Exodus 7:12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all that with purpose of heart they would cleave to the Lord.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Colossians 2:3 (AV) In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom & knowledge.
- Colossians 2:3 (NKJV) in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
- Exodus 33:20-23 And He said, Thou canst not see My face: for there shall no

- Colossians 2:4 And this I say, lest any man should beguile <3884> you with enticing words.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving <3884> your own selves.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Isaiah 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Genesis 3:13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent <u>beguiled</u> me, and I did eat.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath

- God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Genesis 29:25 And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it *was* Leah: and he said to Laban, What *is* this thou hast done unto me? did not I serve with thee for Rachel? wherefore then hast thou <u>beguiled</u> me?
- Genesis 37:28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.
- Numbers 25:18 For they vex you with their wiles, wherewith they have <u>beguiled</u> you in the matter of Peor, and in the matter of Cozbi, the daughter of a prince of Midian, their sister, which was slain in the day of the plague for Peor's sake.
- Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Joshua 13:22 Balaam also the son of Beor, the soothsayer, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them.
- Joshua 9:22 And Joshua called for them, and he spake unto them, saying, Wherefore have ye <u>beguiled</u> us, saying, We *are* very far from you; when ye dwell among us?
- Numbers 27:18,23 And the LORD said unto Moses, Take thee Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay thine hand upon him; 23 And he laid his hands upon him, and gave him a charge, as the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.

- Strongs #4086 pithanologia *pith-an-ol-og-ee'-ah* AV-enticing words 1; 1) speech adapted to persuade, discourse in which probable arguments are adduced 2) in a bad sense, persuasiveness of speech, specious discourse leading others into error.
- Genesis 3:13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent <u>beguiled</u> me, and I did eat.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, & to kill, & to destroy: I am come that they might have life, & that they might have it more abundantly. Referred to God's battle tactics in the Old Testament.
- Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which <u>deceiveth the whole world</u>: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- Revelation 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, & hearing by the Word of God. Revelation 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by *the means of*
- those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak 2 or 3, and let the other judge.
- Revelation 18:23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for <u>by thy sorceries were all nations deceived</u>.
- 1 Kings 18:13 Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD'S prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he <u>deceived</u> them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

- Strongs #5578 pseudoprophetes psyoo-dop-rof-ay'-tace AV-false prophet 11; 1) one who, acting the part of a divinely inspired prophet, utters falsehoods under the name of divine prophecies 2) a false prophet
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Mark 9:28,29 And when He was come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, Why could not we cast him out? 29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Revelation 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should <u>deceive the nations no more</u>, till the 1 years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.
- Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- Revelation 20:8 And shall go out to <u>deceive</u> the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.
- Revelation 20:10 And the devil that <u>deceived</u> them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
- Daniel 10 Referred to the spiritual battle in the heavenlies before on earth.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- 2 Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus;
