- Colossians 2:5 (NKJV) For though I am absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your *good* order and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ.

- Colossians 2:13 (AV) And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses; Colossians 2:13 (NKJV) And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,
- **Revelation 3 Referred to the Laodicean letter.**
- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus' temptations & replying to the devil with "It is written..."
- Colossians 2:14 (AV) Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross;
- Colossians 2:14 (NKJV) having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
- Colossians 2:15 (AV) *And* having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.
- Colossians 2:15 (NKJV) Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
- Colossians 2:16 (AV) Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an Holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath *days*:
- Colossians 2:16 (NKJV) So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths,
- Matthew 15:2 Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.
- Matthew 23:4 For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay them on men's shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers.

- Colossians 2:17 (NKJV) which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.
- Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
- Colossians 2:18 (AV) Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
- Colossians 2:18 (NKJV) Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in *false* humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
- Genesis 3 Referred to the deception & fall of mankind.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels?
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- Colossians 2:19 (AV) And not holding the Head, from Which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.
- Colossians 2:19 (NKJV) and not holding fast to the Head, from Whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase *that is* from God.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;
- 1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
- Colossians 2:20 (AV) Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,
- Colossians 2:20 (NKJV) Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations —
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and

acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- Matthew 15:17,18 Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught? 18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.
- Colossians 2:22 (AV) Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?
- Colossians 2:22 (NKJV) which all concern things which perish with the using according to the commandments and doctrines of men?
- Colossians 2:23 (AV) Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.
- Colossians 2:23 (NKJV) These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, *false* humility, and neglect of the body, *but are* of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
