- Romans 15:20 Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man's foundation:

- 1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Matthew 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
- 1 Corinthians 1:14 (AV) I thank God that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius;

- John 10:19 There was a division <4978> therefore again among the Jews for these sayings.
- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions <4978> among you; but *that* ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 1 Corinthians 11:18 For first of all, when ye come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions <4978> among you; and I partly believe it.
- 1 Corinthians 12:25 That there should be no schism <4978> in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.
- Matthew 12:25,26 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom <u>divided</u> against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house <u>divided</u> against itself shall not stand: 26 And if Satan cast out Satan, he is <u>divided</u> against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?
- Matthew 25:32 And before Him shall be gathered all nations: and He shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd <u>divideth</u> *His* sheep from the goats:
- Mark 3:24-26 And if a kingdom be <u>divided</u> against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. 25 And if a house be <u>divided</u> against itself, that house cannot stand. 26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be <u>divided</u>, he cannot stand. but hath an end.
- Mark 6:41 And when He had taken the five loaves and the two fishes, He looked up to heaven, and blessed, and brake the loaves, and gave *them* to His disciples to set before them; and the two fishes <u>divided</u> He among them all.
- Luke 11:17,18 But He, knowing their thoughts, said unto them, Every kingdom <u>divided</u> against itself is brought to desolation; and a house <u>divided</u> against a house falleth. 18 If Satan also be <u>divided</u> against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out devils through Beelzebub.
- Mark 3:29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

- Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and <u>divideth</u> his spoils.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- Luke 12:13,14 And one of the company said unto Him, Master, speak to my brother, that he <u>divide</u> the inheritance with me. 14 And He said unto him, man, who made Me a judge or a <u>divider</u> over you?
- Luke 12:52,53 For from henceforth there shall be five in one house <u>divided</u>, three against two, and two against three. 53 The father shall be <u>divided</u> against the son, and the son against the father; the mother against the daughter, and the daughter against the mother; the mother in law against her daughter in law, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.
