- Matthew 2:11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down, and worshipped Him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

- Luke 2:1 (AV) And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed.

- Luke 2:3 (NKJV) So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city.
- Luke 2:4 (AV) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)
- Luke 2:4 (NKJV) Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David,
- Luke 2:5 (AV) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with Child.
- Luke 2:5 (NKJV) to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with Child.
- Luke 2:6 (AV) And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Luke 2:17 (AV) And when they had seen *it*, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child.

- Luke 2:28 (AV) Then took he Him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

- Luke 2:29 (AV) Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to Thy Word:

- Luke 2:35 (NKJV) (yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.
- Matthew 26:28 For this is My blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- Luke 2:36 (AV) And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity;

- Isaiah 58 Referred to God's chosen fast.
- Daniel 10 referred to Daniel's fast.
- Luke 2:38 (AV) And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.
- Luke 2:38 (NKJV) And coming in that instant she gave thanks to the Lord,

- and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.
- Luke 2:39 (AV) And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.
- Luke 2:39 (NKJV) So when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their *own* city, Nazareth.
- Luke 2:40 (AV) And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.

- Luke 2:45 (AV) And when they found Him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking Him.
- Luke 2:45 (NKJV) So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him.
- Luke 2:46 (AV) And it came to pass, that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.
- Luke 2:46 (NKJV) Now so it was *that* after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.

- Luke 2:47 (AV) And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- Luke 2:47 (NKJV) And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of His mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.
