- Luke 3:1-38 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 3:1 (AV) Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,
- Luke 3:1 (NKJV) Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judea, Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, his brother Philip tetrarch of Iturea and the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene,
- Luke 3:2 (AV) Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the Word of God came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.
- Luke 3:2 (NKJV) while Annas and Caiaphas were high priests, the Word of God came to John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.
- Luke 3:3 (AV) And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;

- Mark 7:11 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 4:25,26 The woman saith unto Him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when He is come, He will tell us all things. 26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am He.

- Matthew 13 Referred to the Parable of Sower V40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.

done, and not to leave the other undone.
