- 1 Corinthians 2:8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Matthew 4 Referred to a parallel passage.
- Exodus 20:20 And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the sin & downfall of mankind.
- Revelation 20:7,8 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.
- Revelation 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Luke 4:1-13 (AV) & (NKJV)

- Luke 4:1 (AV) And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

- Isaiah 58 Referred to the types of fasts.
- **Daniel 9 Referred to Daniel's fast.**
- Luke 4:3 (AV) And the devil said unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.
- Luke 4:3 (NKJV) And the devil said to Him, If You are the Son of God,

- command this stone to become bread.
- Summarized of Israel murmuring against God when problems arose.
- Strongs #1228 diabolos *dee-ab'-ol-os* AV-devil 35, false accuser 2, slanderer 1; 38 1) prone to slander, slanderous, accusing falsely 1a) a calumniator, false accuser, slanderer, 2) metaph. applied to a man who, by opposing the cause of God, may be said to act the part of the devil or to side with him.
- Satan the prince of the demons, the author of evil, persecuting good men, estranging mankind from God and enticing them to sin, afflicting them with diseases by means of demons who take possession of their bodies at his bidding.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Referred to others killed because of Achan's sin & David numbering Israel.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Revelation 3:8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept My Word, and hast not denied My Name.
- Exodus 20:20 (NKJV) And Moses said to the people, Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin.

- Luke 4:6 (AV) And the devil said unto Him, All this power will I give Thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.
- Luke 4:6 (NKJV) And the devil said to Him, All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for *this* has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.
- Revelation 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,
- Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be
