- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from Him for a season.
- Summarized of satan in Judas Iscariot doing God's will that Grace is poured out to mankind when Jesus died for the sins of the world.
- John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.
- Philippians 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on Him, but also to suffer for His sake;
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Luke 4:14-44 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 4:14 And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of Him through all the region round about.
- Luke 4:14 Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the devil deceiving Adam & Eve to sin.
- Luke 4:15 (AV) And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.
- Luke 4:15 (NKJV) And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.
- Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the Word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.
- Luke 4:16 (AV) And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: and, as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.
- Luke 4:16 (NKJV) So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.
- Luke 4:17 (AV) And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written,
- Luke 4:17 (NKJV) And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:
- Revelation 22:18,19 For I testify unto every man that heareth the Words of the prophecy of this Book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this Book: 19 And if any man shall take away from the Words of the Book of this prophecy, God

- shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the Holy city, and from the things which are written in this Book.
- Luke 4:18 (AV) The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon Me, because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,
- Luke 4:18 (NKJV) The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to *the* poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to *the* captives And recovery of sight to *the* blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;
- Isaiah 61:1-3 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me; because the LORD hath anointed Me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He hath sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; 2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; 3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- John 8:32 And ye shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free. John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.

Luke 19:37-40 And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen; 38 Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. 39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples. 40 And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

- Luke 4:19 (AV) To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
- Luke 4:19 (NKJV) To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning the temple twice.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Luke 4:20 (AV) And He closed the Book, and He gave *it* again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him.
- Luke 4:20 (NKJV) Then He closed the Book, and gave *it* back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him.
- Luke 4:21 (AV) And He began to say unto them, This day is this Scripture fulfilled in your ears.
- Luke 4:21 (NKJV) And He began to say to them, Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.
- Referred to that Jesus revealed Himself to people first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- Luke 4:22 (AV) And all bare Him witness, and wondered at the gracious Words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's Son?
- Luke 4:22 (NKJV) So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the gracious Words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, Is this not Joseph's Son?
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- John 10:9 I am the door: by Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an

- observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, ...
- Luke 4:23 (AV) And He said unto them, Ye will surely say unto Me this proverb, Physician, heal Thyself: whatsoever we have heard done in Capernaum, do also here in Thy country.
- Luke 4:23 (NKJV) He said to them, You will surely say this proverb to Me, Physician, heal yourself! Whatever we have heard done in Capernaum, do also here in Your country.
- Matthew 11:23 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.
- Numbers 13 & 14 Summarized of the bad report from the spies.
- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- **Exodus 32 Summarized of Israel sinning against God.**
- Luke 4:24 (AV) And He said, Verily I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.
- Luke 4:24 (NKJV) Then He said, Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country.
- Luke 4:25 (AV) But I tell you of a truth, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land;
- Luke 4:25 (NKJV) But I tell you truly, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, and there was a great famine throughout all the land;
- Luke 4:26 (AV) But unto none of them was Elias sent, save unto Sarepta, *a city* of Sidon, unto a woman *that was* a widow.
- Luke 4:26 (NKJV) but to none of them was Elijah sent except to Zarephath, in the region of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow.
- 1 Kings 17:9,10 Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which *belongeth* to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee. 10 So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman *was* there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.
- Summarized of God protecting Elijah while Jezebel had many of God's prophets killed & that Obadiah hid some in caves.
- Luke 4:27 (AV) And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Eliseus the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, saving Naaman the Syrian.
- Luke 4:27 (NKJV) And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet, and none of them was cleansed except Naaman the Syrian.
- 2 Kings 5:9,10 So Naaman came with his horses and with his chariot, and

- stood at the door of the house of Elisha. 10 And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean.
- Exodus 4:6,7 And the LORD said furthermore unto him, Put now thine hand into thy bosom. And he put his hand into his bosom: and when he took it out, behold, his hand was leprous as snow. 7 And he said, Put thine hand into thy bosom again. And he put his hand into his bosom again; and plucked it out of his bosom, and, behold, it was turned again as his other flesh.
- 2 Kings 5:11-13 But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the Name of the LORD his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper. 12 *Are* not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage. 13 And his servants came near, and spake unto him, and said, My father, *if* the prophet had bid thee *do some* great thing, wouldest thou not have done *it*? how much rather then, when he saith to thee, Wash, and be clean?
- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- 2 Kings 5:14 Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean. 15 And he returned to the man of God, he and all his company, and came, and stood before him: and he said, Behold, now I know that *there is* no God in all the earth, but in Israel: now therefore, I pray thee, take a blessing of thy servant. 16 But he said, *As* the LORD liveth, before whom I stand, I will receive none. And he urged him to take *it*; but he refused.
- Acts 20:35 I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the Words of the Lord Jesus, how He said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.
- Referred to Gehazi taking gifts & lying & then got leprosy.
- Luke 4:28 (AV) And all they in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath,
- Luke 4:28 (NKJV) So all those in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath,
- Acts 7:57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon Him with one accord,
- Luke 4:29 (AV) And rose up, and thrust Him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong.
- Luke 4:29 (NKJV) and rose up and thrust Him out of the city; and they led

- Him to the brow of the hill on which their city was built, that they might throw Him down over the cliff.
- Luke 22 Summarized of the kangaroo court justice when Jesus was arrested & killed.
- Luke 4:30 (AV) But He passing through the midst of them went His way,
- Luke 4:30 (NKJV) Then passing through the midst of them, He went His way.
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 8 They shall take up serpents; (MISS-USED) and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Acts 28:3-5 And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. 4 And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. 5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm.
- Luke 4:31 (AV) And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.
- Luke 4:31 (NKJV) Then He went down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and was teaching them on the Sabbaths.
- Luke 4:32 (AV) And they were astonished at His doctrine: for His Word was with power.
- Luke 4:32 (NKJV) And they were astonished at His teaching, for His Word was with authority.
- Luke 4:33 (AV) And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice,
- Luke 4:33 (NKJV) Now in the synagogue there was a man who had a spirit of an unclean demon. And he cried out with a loud voice,
- Strongs #1140 daimonion *dahee-mon'-ee-on* AV-devil 59, god 1; 60 1) the divine power, deity, divinity 2) a spirit, a being inferior to God, superior to men 3) evil spirits or the messengers and ministers of the devil.
- Mark 16:18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 4:34 (AV) Saying, Let *us* alone; what have we to do with Thee, *Thou*Jesus of Nazareth? art Thou come to destroy us? I know Thee Who Thou
  art; the Holy One of God.
- Luke 4:34 (NKJV) saying, Let *us* alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know Who You are the Holy One of God!
- Mark 5:9 And He asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, my

- name is Legion: for we are many.
- Luke 8:30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.
- Strongs #622 apollumi *ap-ol'-loo-mee* AV-perish 33, destroy 26, lose 22, be lost 5, lost 4, misc 2; 92 1) to destroy 1a) to put out of the way entirely, abolish, put an end to ruin 1b) render useless 1c) to kill 1d) to declare that one must be put to death 1e) metaph. to devote or give over to eternal misery in hell 1f) to perish, to be lost, ruined, destroyed 2) to destroy 2a) to lose.
- Luke 4:35 (AV) And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.
- Luke 4:35 (NKJV) But Jesus rebuked him, saying, Be quiet, and come out of him! And when the demon had thrown him in *their* midst, it came out of him and did not hurt him.
- Referred to modern false deliverance methods.
- Deuteronomy 18:10,11 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord:
- Luke 4:36 (AV) And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word *is* this! for with authority and power He commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.
- Luke 4:36 (NKJV) Then they were all amazed and spoke among themselves, saying, What a word this *is*! For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out.
- Luke 4:37 (AV) And the fame of Him went out into every place of the country round about.
- Luke 4:37 (NKJV) And the report about Him went out into every place in the surrounding region.
- Luke 4:38 (AV) And He arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they besought Him for her.

- Luke 4:38 (NKJV) Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her.
- Luke 4:39 (AV) And He stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.
- Luke 4:39 (NKJV) So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Luke 4:40 (AV) Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them, and healed them.
- Luke 4:40 (NKJV) When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.
- 1 Corinthians 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
- Luke 4:41 (AV) And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And He rebuking *them* suffered them not to speak: for they knew that He was Christ.
- Luke 4:41 (NKJV) And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, You are the Christ, the Son of God! And He, rebuking *them*, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.
- Luke 4:42 (AV) And when it was day, He departed and went into a desert place: and the people sought Him, and came unto Him, and stayed Him, that He should not depart from them.
- Luke 4:42 (NKJV) Now when it was day, He departed and went into a deserted place. And the crowd sought Him and came to Him, and tried to keep Him from leaving them;
- Luke 4:43 (AV) And He said unto them, I must preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.
- Luke 4:43 (NKJV) but He said to them, I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent.
- Luke 4:44 (AV) And He preached in the synagogues of Galilee.
- Luke 4:44 (NKJV) And He was preaching in the synagogues of Galilee.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
