- Luke 5:17 (AV) And it came to pass on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was *present* to heal them.
- Luke 5:17 (NKJV) Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was *present* to heal them.
- Matthew 3:7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Exodus 7:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart is hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.
- Ezekiel 11:19 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:
- Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- Luke 5:18 (AV) And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought *means* to bring him in, and to lay *him* before Him.

- Luke 5:19 (NKJV) And when they could not find how they might bring him in, because of the crowd, they went up on the housetop and let him down with *his* bed through the tiling into the midst before Jesus.
- Mark 10:47-49 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a

- great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee.
- Luke 18:3,5 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord:
- Luke 5:20 (AV) And when He saw their faith, He said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.
- Luke 5:20 (NKJV) When He saw their faith, He said to him, Man, your sins are forgiven you.
- Luke 5:21 (AV) And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?
- Luke 5:21 (NKJV) And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?
- Strongs #1260 dialogizomai *dee-al-og-id'-zom-ahee* AV-reason 11, dispute 1, cast in the mind 1, muse 1, think 1, consider 1; 16 1) to bring together different reasons, to reckon up the reasons, to reason, revolve in one's mind, deliberate.
- Luke 4:28-30 And all they in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath, 29 And rose up, and thrust Him out of the city, and led Him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong. 30 But He passing through the midst of them went His way.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- Luke 5:22 (AV) But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answering said unto them, What reason ye in your hearts?
- Luke 5:22 (NKJV) But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answered and said to them, Why are you reasoning in your hearts?
- Luke 5:23 (AV) Whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Rise up and walk?
- Luke 5:23 (NKJV) Which is easier, to say, Your sins are forgiven you, or to say, Rise up and walk?

- Luke 5:24 (AV) But that ye may know that the Son of Man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (He said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.
- Luke 5:24 (NKJV) But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins He said to the man who was paralyzed, I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.
- John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- John 5:14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
- John 9:2 And His disciples asked Him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Luke 5:25 (AV) And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.
- Luke 5:25 (NKJV) Immediately he rose up before them, took up what he had been lying on, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.
- Acts 3:8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Luke 5:26 (AV) And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.
- Luke 5:26 (NKJV) And they were all amazed, and they glorified God and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things today!
- Luke 5:27 (AV) And after these things He went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He said unto him, Follow Me.
- Luke 5:27 (NKJV) After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, Follow Me.
- Acts 9:3 And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: 4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me? Luke 5:28 (AV) And he left all, rose up, and followed Him.

- Luke 5:28 (NKJV) So he left all, rose up, and followed Him.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him.
- The Gospel of Matthew shows that Jesus Christ was the fulfilment of prophesy.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Luke 5:29 (AV) And Levi made Him a great feast in his own house: and there was a great company of publicans and of others that sat down with them.
- Luke 5:29 (NKJV) Then Levi gave Him a great feast in his own house. And there were a great number of tax collectors and others who sat down with them.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Luke 5:30 (AV) But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against His disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?
- Luke 5:30 (NKJV) And their scribes and the Pharisees complained against His disciples, saying, Why do You eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 5:31 (AV) And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.
- Luke 5:31 (NKJV) Jesus answered and said to them, Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Luke 5:32 (AV) I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- Luke 5:32 (NKJV) I have not come to call *the* righteous, but sinners, to repentance.
- Judges 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.
- Judges 3:7 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgat the LORD their God, and served Baalim and the groves.
- Luke 5:33 (AV) And they said unto Him, Why do the disciples of John fast

- often, and make prayers, and likewise *the disciples* of the Pharisees; but Thine eat and drink?
- Luke 5:33 (NKJV) Then they said to Him, Why do the disciples of John fast often and make prayers, and likewise those of the Pharisees, but Yours eat and drink?
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Luke 5:34 (AV) And He said unto them, Can ye make the children of the bridechamber fast, while the Bridegroom is with them?
- Luke 5:34 (NKJV) And He said to them, Can you make the friends of the bridegroom fast while the bridegroom is with them?
- Luke 5:35 (AV) But the days will come, when the Bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.
- Luke 5:35 (NKJV) But the days will come when the bridegroom will be taken away from them; then they will fast in those days.
- Isaiah 58 Referred to God's chosen fast.
- Luke 5:36 (AV) And he spake also a parable unto them; No man putteth a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new maketh a rent, and the piece that was *taken* out of the new agreeth not with the old.
- Luke 5:36 (NKJV) Then He spoke a parable to them: No one puts a piece from a new garment on an old one; otherwise the new makes a tear, and also the piece that was *taken* out of the new does not match the old.
- Colossians 3:8-10 But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. 9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; 10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the Image of Him that created Him:
- Luke 5:37 (AV) And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.
- Luke 5:37 (NKJV) And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; or else the new wine will burst the wineskins and be spilled, and the wineskins will be ruined.

- Luke 5:38 (AV) But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved.
- Luke 5:38 (NKJV) But new wine must be put into new wineskins, and both are preserved.
- Luke 5:39 (AV) No man also having drunk old *wine* straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.
- Luke 5:39 (NKJV) And no one, having drunk old *wine*, immediately desires new; for he says, The old is better.
- Acts 2:44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common; Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Daniel 1:15 And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat.
- Daniel 1:19,20 And the king communed with them; and among them all was found none like Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah: therefore stood they before the king. 20 And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, that the king enquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm.
- Philippians 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on Him, but also to suffer for His sake;
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
