## Jesus Christ Confronts Legalism - Luke 6A

- John 10:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,
- Matthew 12 Referred to a parallel passage.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- Luke 6:1-20 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 6:1 (AV) And it came to pass on the second Sabbath after the first, that He went through the corn (grain) fields; and His disciples plucked the ears of corn, and did eat, rubbing *them* in *their* hands.
- Luke 6:1 (NKJV) Now it happened on the second Sabbath after the first that He went through the grainfields. And His disciples plucked the heads of grain and ate *them*, rubbing *them* in *their* hands.
- Deuteronomy 23:25 When thou comest into the standing corn of thy neighbour, then thou mayest pluck the ears with thine hand; but thou shalt not move a sickle unto thy neighbour's standing corn.
- Luke 6:2 (AV) And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the Sabbath days?
- Luke 6:2 (NKJV) And some of the Pharisees said to them, Why are you doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath?
- Matthew 12:11 And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out?
- Compaired the 10 Commandments & the Beatitudes replacing them in the New Covenent.
- Luke 6:3 (AV) And Jesus answering them said, Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungred, and they which were with him;
- Luke 6:3 (NKJV) But Jesus answering them said, Have you not even read

- this, what David did when he was hungry, he and those who were with him:
- 1 Samuel 21 Referred to the passage of David & Ahimelech.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- 1 Samuel 16:23 And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
- Luke 6:4 (AV) How he went into the house of God, and did take and eat the shewbread, and gave also to them that were with him; which it is not lawful to eat but for the priests alone?
- Luke 6:4 (NKJV) how he went into the house of God, took and ate the showbread, and also gave some to those with him, which is not lawful for any but the priests to eat?
- Exodus 25:30 And thou shalt set upon the table shewbread before Me alway.
- Luke 6:5 (AV) And He said unto them, That the Son of Man is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- Luke 6:5 (NKJV) And He said to them, The Son of Man is also Lord of the Sabbath.
- Romans 14:5,6 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind. 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.
- Luke 6:6 (AV) And it came to pass also on another Sabbath, that He entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.
- Luke 6:6 (NKJV) Now it happened on another Sabbath, also, that He entered the synagogue and taught. And a man was there whose right hand was withered.
- Luke 6:7 (AV) And the scribes and Pharisees watched Him, whether He would heal on the Sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against Him.
- Luke 6:7 (NKJV) So the scribes and Pharisees watched Him closely, whether He would heal on the Sabbath, that they might find an accusation against Him.
- Matthew 3:7.8 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees

- come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come? 8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
- John 8 Referred to the woman taken in adultry brought before Jesus.
- Luke 6:8 (AV) But He knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.
- Luke 6:8 (NKJV) But He knew their thoughts, and said to the man who had the withered hand, Arise and stand here. And he arose and stood.
- Psalms 94:11 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity.
- Luke 6:9 (AV) Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the Sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy *it*?
- Luke 6:9 (NKJV) Then Jesus said to them, I will ask you one thing: Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do evil, to save life or to destroy?
- Mark 11:30 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? answer Me.
- Strongs #2554 kakopoieo kak-op-oy-eh'-o AV-do evil 3, evil doing 1; 4 1) to do harm 2) to do evil, do wrong.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Matthew 21:25-27 The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him? 26 But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet. 27 And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.
- Luke 6:10 (AV) And looking round about upon them all, He said unto the man, Stretch forth thy hand. And he did so: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- Luke 6:10 (NKJV) And when He had looked around at them all, He said to the man, Stretch out your hand. And he did so, and his hand was restored as whole as the other.
- Matthew 26:63 But Jesus held His peace. And the high priest answered and said unto Him, I adjure Thee by the living God, that Thou tell us whether Thou be the Christ, the Son of God.
- Luke 6:11 (AV) And they were filled with madness; and communed one with another what they might do to Jesus.

- Luke 6:11 (NKJV) But they were filled with rage, and discussed with one another what they might do to Jesus.
- Acts 3:6,8 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. 8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.
- Strongs #454 anoia an'-oy-ah AV-madness 1, folly 1; 2 1) want of understanding, folly 2) madness expressing itself in rage.
- Luke 6:12 (AV) And it came to pass in those days, that He went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.
- Luke 6:12 (NKJV) Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.
- Matthew 21:15,16 And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the Son of David; they were sore displeased, 16 And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?
- Luke 6:13 (AV) And when it was day, He called *unto Him* His disciples: and of them He chose twelve, whom also He named apostles;
- Luke 6:13 (NKJV) And when it was day, He called His disciples to *Himself*; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles:
- Judges 7 Referred to Gideon's army pared down by God.
- Matthew 28:16-20 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them. 17 And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. 19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.
- Luke 6:14 (AV) Simon, (whom He also named Peter,) and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,
- Luke 6:14 (NKJV) Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew;
- Luke 6:15 (AV) Matthew and Thomas, James the *son* of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,
- Luke 6:15 (NKJV) Matthew and Thomas; James the *son* of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot;

- Luke 6:16 (AV) And Judas *the brother* of James, and Judas Iscariot, which also was the traitor.
- Luke 6:16 (NKJV) Judas *the son* of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil (diabolos)?
- Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- John 13:27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Luke 6:17 (AV) And He came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of His disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear Him, and to be healed of their diseases;
- Luke 6:17 (NKJV) And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases,
- Luke 6:18 (AV) And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.
- Luke 6:18 (NKJV) as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Luke 6:19 (AV) And the whole multitude sought to touch Him: for there went virtue out of Him, and healed *them* all.
- Luke 6:19 (NKJV) And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed *them* all.
- Matthew 9:20-22 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind Him, and touched the hem of His garment: 21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole. 22 But Jesus turned him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.
- Luke 6:20 (AV) And He lifted up His eyes on His disciples, and said, Blessed

- be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.
- Luke 6:20 (NKJV) Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said: Blessed *are you* poor, For yours is the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 5-7 Referred to a similar passage on the Beatitudes.
- Strongs #3107 makarios mak-ar'-ee-os AV-blessed 44, happy 5, happier 1; 50 1) blessed, happy.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die.
- Luke 23 Summarized of the afflictions of Jesus V34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Luke 16:22,23 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
