## **Godly Teachings - Luke 6B**

- The Beatitudes are Jesus' New Testament equivalent of the 10 Commandments.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Isaiah 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a Word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- Luke 6:5 And He said unto them, That the Son of Man is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- Luke 6:20-49 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 6:20 (AV) And He lifted up His eyes on His disciples, and said, Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.
- Luke 6:20 (NKJV) Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said: Blessed *are you* poor, For yours is the kingdom of God.
- James 2:5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which He hath promised to them that love Him?
- Luke 6:21 (AV) Blessed *are ye* that hunger now: for ye shall be filled. Blessed *are ye* that weep now: for ye shall laugh.
- Luke 6:21 (NKJV) Blessed *are you* who hunger now, For you shall be filled. Blessed *are you* who weep now, For you shall laugh.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:
- Luke 3:3 And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;
- John 6:48 I am that Bread of Life.
- John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.
- Philippians 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

- Luke 6:22 (AV) Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you *from their company*, and shall reproach *you*, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of Man's sake.
- Luke 6:22 (NKJV) Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile *you*, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of Man's sake.
- Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Matthew 5:15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- Revelation 13:16,17 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: 17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- Luke 6:23 (AV) Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward *is* great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.
- Luke 6:23 (NKJV) Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward *is* great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Matthew 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!
- Luke 6:24 (AV) But woe unto you that are rich! for ye have received your consolation.
- Luke 6:24 (NKJV) But woe to you who are rich, For you have received your

- consolation.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' woes on the religious leaders.
- Luke 12 Summarized of the parable of the rich man. V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Luke 16 Referred to the parable of the rich man & Lazarus
- Mark 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- Mark 15:43,46 Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus. 46 And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.
- Mark 10:21,22 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Luke 6:25 (AV) Woe unto you that are full! for ye shall hunger. Woe unto you that laugh now! for ye shall mourn and weep.
- Luke 6:25 (NKJV) Woe to you who are full, For you shall hunger. Woe to you who laugh now, For you shall mourn and weep.
- Luke 16:23,24 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Luke 6:26 (AV) Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! for so did their fathers to the false prophets.
- Luke 6:26 (NKJV) Woe to you when all men speak well of you, For so did their fathers to the false prophets.
- 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- Luke 6:27 (AV) But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you,

- Luke 6:27 (NKJV) But I say to you who hear: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you,
- Luke 9:54,55 And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said, Lord, wilt Thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did? 55 But He turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of.
- Luke 6:28 (AV) Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.
- Luke 6:28 (NKJV) bless those who curse you, and pray for those who spitefully use you.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.
- Acts 9 Referred to Saul Saved V6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt Thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.
- Luke 6:29 (AV) And unto him that smiteth thee on the *one* cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not *to take thy* coat also.
- Luke 6:29 (NKJV) To him who strikes you on the *one* cheek, offer the other also. And from him who takes away your cloak, do not withhold *your* tunic either.
- Matthew 18:21 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Luke 6:30 (AV) Give to every man that asketh of thee; and of him that taketh away thy goods ask *them* not again.
- Luke 6:30 (NKJV) Give to everyone who asks of you. And from him who takes away your goods do not ask *them* back.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- Luke 6:31 (AV) And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.

- Luke 6:31 (NKJV) And just as you want men to do to you, you also do to them likewise.
- Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Matthew 5:38 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Luke 6:32 (AV) For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners also love those that love them.
- Luke 6:32 (NKJV) But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- John 13:26,27 Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when He had dipped the sop, He gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. 27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Luke 6:33 (AV) And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners also do even the same.
- Luke 6:33 (NKJV) And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same.
- Luke 10 Summarized the parable of the Good Samaritan.
- Luke 6:34 (AV) And if ye lend *to them* of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.
- Luke 6:34 (NKJV) And if you lend *to those* from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back.
- Luke 6:35 (AV) But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for He is kind unto the unthankful and *to* the evil.
- Luke 6:35 (NKJV) But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for He maketh His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Luke 6:36 (AV) Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.
- Luke 6:36 (NKJV) Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is

- merciful.
- Psalms 103:10 He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.
- Mercy Not receiving the punishment we deserve.
- Grace God's unmerrited favour we do not deserve.
- Luke 6:37 (AV) Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:
- Luke 6:37 (NKJV) Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.
- Matthew 7:1,2 Judge not, that ye be not judged. 2 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.
- Matthew 6:12,14,15 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Luke 6:38 (AV) Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
- Luke 6:38 (NKJV) Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.
- Luke 6:39 (AV) And He spake a parable unto them, Can the blind lead the blind? shall they not both fall into the ditch?
- Luke 6:39 (NKJV) And He spoke a parable to them: Can the blind lead the blind? Will they not both fall into the ditch?
- 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- Luke 6:40 (AV) The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master.
- Luke 6:40 (NKJV) A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher.
- Luke 6:41 (AV) And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye?
- Luke 6:41 (NKJV) And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye,

- but do not perceive the plank in your own eye?
- Matthew 23:13A But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!...
- Referred to abuse covered up in many other religions like Roman Catholicism, etc.
- Luke 6:42 (AV) Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.
- Luke 6:42 (NKJV) Or how can you say to your brother, Brother, let me remove the speck that *is* in your eye, when you yourself do not see the plank that *is* in your own eye? Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Luke 6:43 (AV) For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt fruit; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.
- Luke 6:43 (NKJV) For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit.
- 1 Samuel 4:21 And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband.
- Luke 6:44 (AV) For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes.
- Luke 6:44 (NKJV) For every tree is known by its own fruit. For *men* do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.
- Luke 6:45 (AV) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.
- Luke 6:45 (NKJV) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.
- Mark 7:21-23 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.

- Luke 6:46 (AV) And why call ye Me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?
- Luke 6:46 (NKJV) But why do you call Me Lord, Lord, and do not do the things which I say?
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Luke 6:47 (AV) Whosoever cometh to Me, and heareth My sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like:
- Luke 6:47 (NKJV) Whoever comes to Me, and hears My sayings and does them, I will show you whom he is like:
- Luke 6:48 (AV) He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.
- Luke 6:48 (NKJV) He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock.
- Luke 6:49 (AV) But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.
- Luke 6:49 (NKJV) But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a house on the earth without a foundation, against which the stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin of that house was great.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In M Nme shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
