- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Luke 6:5 And He said unto them, That the Son of Man is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- Luke 7:1-10 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 7:1 (AV) Now when He had ended all His sayings in the audience of the people, He entered into Capernaum.
- Luke 7:1 (NKJV) Now when He concluded all His sayings in the hearing of the people, He entered Capernaum.
- Luke 7:2 (AV) And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.
- Luke 7:2 (NKJV) And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear to him, was sick and ready to die.
- Mark 7 Sumarized of the Syrophenician woman coming to Jesus to deliver her demonized daughter. V29,30 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter. 30 And when she was come to her house, she found the devil gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.
- John 19:15 But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.
- Luke 7:3 (AV) And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto Him the elders of the Jews, beseeching Him that He would come and heal his servant.
- Luke 7:3 (NKJV) So when he heard about Jesus, he sent elders of the Jews to Him, pleading with Him to come and heal his servant.
- Mark 2:3 And they come unto Him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.
- Luke 7:4 (AV) And when they came to Jesus, they be sought Him instantly, saying. That he was worthy for whom He should do this:
- Luke 7:4 (NKJV) And when they came to Jesus, they begged Him earnestly, saying that the one for whom He should do this was deserving,
- Acts 10 Referred to Cornelius & God having Peter come to minister to him.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Luke 7:5 (AV) For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue.
- Luke 7:5 (NKJV) for he loves our nation, and has built us a synagogue.

- Luke 7:6 (AV) Then Jesus went with them. And when He was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to Him, saying unto Him, Lord, trouble not Thyself: for I am not worthy that Thou shouldest enter under my roof:
- Luke 7:6 (NKJV) Then Jesus went with them. And when He was already not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to Him, saying to Him, Lord, do not trouble Yourself, for I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof.
- Matthew 16:16,17 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God. 17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but My Father which is in heaven.
- 1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Luke 7:7 (AV) Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto Thee: but say in a Word, and my servant shall be healed.

- John 3:1,2 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: 2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto Him, Rabbi, we know that Thou art a Teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that Thou doest, except God be with him.
- Luke 7:8 (AV) For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth *it*.
- Luke 7:8 (NKJV) For I also am a man placed under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to one, Go, and he goes; and to another, Come, and he comes; and to my servant, Do this, and he does *it*.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the Head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the Head of Christ is God.
- Genesis 1:27 So God created man in His Own Image, in the Image of God created He him; male and female created He them.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.

- Luke 7:9 (AV) When Jesus heard these things, He marvelled at him, and turned Him about, and said unto the people that followed Him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

- Numbers 14:22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My voice;
- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe Me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- Luke 4:20,21 And He closed the book (Isaiah 61), and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him. 21 And He began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.
- Luke 7:10 (AV) And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.
- Luke 7:10 (NKJV) And those who were sent, returning to the house, found the servant well who had been sick.
- Mark 8 Summarized of Jesus praying twice for a healing of the blind man.
- Luke 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; (the parable of the persistant widow).
- John 6:14,15 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that Prophet that should come into the world. 15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a king, He departed again into a mountain himself alone.
- Matthew 4:23,24 (AV) & (NKJV)

- Matthew 14:26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.
- John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the Bread of Life: he that cometh to Me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on Me shall never thirst.
- Strongs #3554 nosos nos'-os AV-disease 6, sickness 5, infirmity 1; 12 1)

- disease, sickness.
- Strongs #3119 malakia mal-ak-ee'-ah AV-disease 3; 1) softness 2) in the NT infirmity, debility, bodily weakness, sickness.
- Matthew 4:24 (AV) And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- Matthew 4:24 (NKJV) Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than traditional healing methods.
- John 11:39,43,44 Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto Him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days. 43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.
- Hebrews 13:8 (AV) Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Hebrews 13:8 (NKJV) Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- Mark 16:9-20 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Mark 16:9 (AV) Now when *Jesus* was risen early the first *day* of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils.
- Mark 16:9 (NKJV) Now when *He* rose early on the first *day* of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven demons.
- Luke 8:30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.
- Mark 16:10 (AV) *And* she went and told them that had been with Him, as they mourned and wept.

- Mark 16:10 (NKJV) She went and told those who had been with Him, as they mourned and wept.
- Mark 16:11 (AV) And they, when they had heard that He was alive, and had been seen of her, believed not.
- Mark 16:11 (NKJV) And when they heard that He was alive and had been seen by her, they did not believe.

(Spirit of unbelief in the disciples.)

- Mark 16:12 (AV) After that He appeared in another form unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country.
- Mark 16:12 (NKJV) After that, He appeared in another form to two of them as they walked and went into the country.
- Luke 24 on the road to Emmaus.
- Mark 16:13 (AV) And they went and told *it* unto the residue: neither believed they them.
- Mark 16:13 (NKJV) And they went and told *it* to the rest, *but* they did not believe them either.
- Acts 19 Referred to demons cast out in the New Testament Church after Jesus' ressurection.
- Referred to demons cast out over the years simce then.
- Mark 16:14 (AV) Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen Him after He was risen.
- Mark 16:14 (NKJV) Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen.
- (Spirit of unbelief & hardness of heart in the disciples.)
- Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- 1 Chronicles 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that Thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that Thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Mark 16:15 (AV) And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- Mark 16:15 (NKJV) And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach

- the Gospel to every creature.
- Mark 16:16 (AV) He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Mark 16:16 (NKJV) He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
- Mark 16:17 (AV) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Mark 16:17 (NKJV) And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;
- Mark 16:18 (AV) They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Mark 16:18 (NKJV) they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- 2 John 1:8 Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.
- 1 Corinthians 3:15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,
- Mark 16:19 (AV) So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.
- Mark 16:19 (NKJV) So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.
- Mark 16:20 (AV) And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with *them*, and confirming the Word with signs following. Amen.
- Mark 16:20 (NKJV) And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with *them* and confirming the Word through the accompanying signs. Amen.
