- John 11 Summarized of Lazarus sick, died & risen.
- Acts 5:5,6 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things. 6 And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him.
- 1 Timothy 5:4 But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.
- Luke 7:13 (AV) And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.

- Luke 7:14 (NKJV) Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried *him* stood still. And He said, Young man, I say to you, arise.
- Luke 7:7 Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.
- Luke 7:15 (AV) And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And He delivered him to his mother.
- Luke 7:15 (NKJV) So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Mark 8 summarized of Jesus ministering to heal the sight of a man twice.
- Luke 7:16 (AV) And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great Prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited His people.

- Luke 7:16 (NKJV) Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, A great Prophet has risen up among us; and, God has visited His people.
- In the Gospel of John Jesus reveals Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- Matthew 16:16,17 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God. 17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but My Father which is in heaven.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the Name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by Him.
- Luke 7:17 (AV) And this rumour of Him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about.

- Mark 7 Summarized of the Syrophenician woman's daughter delivered.

 Matthew 9 Summarized of the woman healed of bleeding by touching the hem of Jesus' garment.
- Luke 7:18 (AV) And the disciples of John shewed him of all these things.
- Luke 7:18 (NKJV) Then the disciples of John reported to him concerning all these things.
- John 1:32 And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.
- John 3:30 He must increase, but I must decrease.

- Isaiah 61 & Luke 4 Referred to Jesus reading the Scriptures of His Commission.

- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- John 9:2,3 And His disciples asked Him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Luke 7:23 (AV) And blessed is *he*, whosoever shall not be offended in Me.
