Thanksgiving For Forgiven Sins - Luke 7C

- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

- Luke 7:32 (AV) They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept.

- Luke 7:32 (NKJV) They are like children sitting in the marketplace and calling to one another, saying: We played the flute for you, And you did not dance; We mourned to you, And you did not weep.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.
- Luke 7:33 (AV) For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil.
- Luke 7:33 (NKJV) For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine, and you say, He has a demon.
- Luke 1:15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.
- Luke 7:34 (AV) The Son of Man is come eating & drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous Man, and a Winebibber, a Friend of publicans and sinners!
- Luke 7:34 (NKJV) The Son of Man has come eating and drinking, and you say, Look, a Glutton and a Winebibber, a Friend of tax collectors and sinners! Luke 7:35 (AV) But wisdom is justified of all her children.
- Luke 7:35 (NKJV) But wisdom is justified by all her children.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, & ye are not your own?
- 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

- Luke 7:38 (AV) And stood at His feet behind *Him* weeping, and began to wash His feet with tears, and did wipe *them* with the hairs of her head, and kissed His feet, and anointed *them* with the ointment.
- Luke 7:38 (NKJV) and stood at His feet behind *Him* weeping; and she began to wash His feet with her tears, and wiped *them* with the hair of her head; and she kissed His feet and anointed *them* with the fragrant oil.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Joshua 2 Referred to harlot Rahab turning from her sinful past.
- Luke 7:39 (AV) Now when the Pharisee which had bidden Him saw *it*, he spake within himself, saying, This Man, if he were a Prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman *this is* that toucheth Him: for she is a sinner.

 Luke 7:39 (NKJV) Now when the Pharisee who had invited Him saw *this*, he spoke to himself, saying, This Man, if He were a Prophet, would know who and what manner of woman *this is* who is touching Him, for she is a sinner.
- Luke 7:40 (AV) And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.
- Luke 7:40 (NKJV) And Jesus answered and said to him, Simon, I have something to say to you. So he said, Teacher, say it.
- Luke 7:41 (AV) There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.
- Luke 7:41 (NKJV) There was a certain creditor who had two debtors. One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty.
- Luke 7:42 (AV) And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?
- Luke 7:42 (NKJV) And when they had nothing with which to repay, he freely forgave them both. Tell Me, therefore, which of them will love him more? Matthew 18 Referred to another parable of debtors forgiven.
- Hebrews 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- Luke 7:43 (AV) Simon answered and said, I suppose that *he*, to whom he forgave most. And He said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.
- Luke 7:43 (NKJV) Simon answered and said, I suppose the *one* whom he forgave more. And He said to him, You have rightly judged.
- Luke 7:44 (AV) And He turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest Me no water for My feet: but she hath washed My feet with tears, and wiped *them* with the hairs of her head.

 Luke 7:44 (NKJV) Then He turned to the woman and said to Simon, Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave Me no water for My feet, but she has washed My feet with her tears and wiped *them* with the hair of her head.

- John 13:5,6 After that He poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith He was girded. 6 Then cometh He to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?
- Luke 7:45 (AV) Thou gavest Me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss My feet.
- Luke 7:45 (NKJV) You gave Me no kiss, but this woman has not ceased to kiss My feet since the time I came in.
- Luke 7:46 (AV) My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed My feet with ointment.
- Luke 7:46 (NKJV) You did not anoint My head with oil, but this woman has anointed My feet with fragrant oil.
- Luke 7:47 (AV) Wherefore I say unto thee, her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

 Luke 7:47 (NKJV) Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little.
- John 4:25,26,29 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when He is come, He will tell us all things. 26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am He. 29 Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?
- Luke 19:8 And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Luke 7:48 (AV) And He said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven.
- Luke 7:48 (NKJV) Then He said to her, Your sins are forgiven.
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to Him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until 70 times seven.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 7:49 (AV) And they that sat at meat with Him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?
- Luke 7:49 (NKJV) And those who sat at the table with Him began to say to themselves, Who is this Who even forgives sins?
- Matthew 9:2 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying

- on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.
- Mark 2:10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,)
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.
- Luke 7:50 (AV) And He said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

 Luke 7:50 (NKJV) Then He said to the woman, Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.
- Exodus 8:32 And Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:
- John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

- Psalms 32:5 I acknowledged my sin unto Thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and Thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Daniel 9:8 (AV) O Lord, to us belongeth confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Psalms 103:10 He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.
