

The Word Goes Forth - Luke 8A

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:

Luke 8:1-15 (AV) & (NKJV)

Luke 8:1 (AV) And it came to pass afterward, that He went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve *were* with Him,

Luke 8:1 (NKJV) Now it came to pass, afterward, that He went through every city and village, preaching and bringing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God. And the twelve *were* with Him,

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

In the Gospel of John Jesus reveals Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.

Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

John 14:2,3 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Luke 8:2 (AV) And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and

infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils, Luke 8:2 (NKJV) and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities — Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come 7 demons, 1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

Matthew 9 Referred to the Woman bleeding seeking healing from Jesus.

Mark 7:26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought Him that He would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 9 Summarized of the demonized boy set free by Jesus. V25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. 29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.

Luke 8:3 (AV) And Joanna the wife of Chuza Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others, which ministered unto Him of their substance.

Luke 8:4 (AV) And when much people were gathered together, and were come to Him out of every city, He spake by a parable:

Luke 8:4 (NKJV) And when a great multitude had gathered, and they had come to Him from every city, He spoke by a parable:

Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Luke 8:5 (AV) A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it.

Luke 8:5 (NKJV) A sower went out to sow his seed. And as he sowed, some fell by the wayside (roadside, pathway); and it was trampled down, and the birds of the air devoured it.

Luke 8:6 (AV) And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.

Luke 8:6 (NKJV) Some fell on rock; and as soon as it sprang up, it withered away because it lacked moisture.

Luke 8:7 (AV) And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up with it, and choked it.

Luke 8:7 (NKJV) And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up with it and choked it.

Luke 8:8 (AV) And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare fruit an hundredfold. And when He had said these things, He cried, he that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Luke 8:8 (NKJV) But others fell on good ground, sprang up, and yielded a crop a hundredfold. When He had said these things He cried, he who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Acts 16:30,31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

Luke 8:10 (AV) And He said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.

Luke 8:10 (NKJV) And He said, To you it has been given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God, but to the rest *it is given* in parables, that Seeing they may not see, And hearing they may not understand.

Isaiah 6:9 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not.

Luke 8:11 (AV) Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.

Referred to modern religious leaders, common ways of Scripture miss-used to decieve people.

Luke 8:12 (AV) Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

Luke 8:12 (NKJV) Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.

Mark 16:16,17,20 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Luke 8:13 (NKJV) But the ones on the rock *are those* who, when they hear, receive the Word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away.

Genesis 3 Referred to Eve decieved in the Garden of Eden.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Acts 19:19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of Truth, which proceedeth from the Father, He shall testify of Me:

Luke 8:14 (AV) And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of *this* life, and bring no fruit to perfection.

Luke 8:14 (NKJV) Now the ones *that* fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

1 Corinthians 7:32,33 But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord: 33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife.

Mark 10:20-22 And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. 21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

Luke 8:15 (AV) But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the Word, keep *it*, and bring forth fruit with patience.

Luke 8:15 (NKJV) But the ones *that* fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the Word with a noble and good heart, keep *it* and bear fruit with patience.

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
