999 Letting Your Light Shine - Luke 8B

- 1 Peter 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an Holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light:
- Mark 16:15-18 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Luke 8:16-21 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Luke 8:16 (AV) No man, when he hath lighted a candle, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth *it* under a bed; but setteth *it* on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.
- Luke 8:16 (NKJV) No one, when he has lit a lamp, covers it with a vessel or puts *it* under a bed, but sets *it* on a lampstand, that those who enter may see the light.
- Mark 12:29-31 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. 31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Luke 10 Referred to the Parable of the Good Samaratan.
- Luke 8:17 (AV) For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.
- Luke 8:17 (NKJV) For nothing is secret that will not be revealed, nor *anything* hidden that will not be known and come to light.
- Luke 8:18 (AV) Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.
- Luke 8:18 (NKJV) Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him *more* will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he seems to

- have will be taken from him.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Matthew 25 Referred to the Parable of the Talents. V28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.
- Luke 8:10 And He said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.
- Luke 8:19 (AV) Then came to Him *His* mother and His brethren, and could not come at Him for the press.
- Luke 8:19 (NKJV) Then His mother and brothers came to Him, and could not approach Him because of the crowd.
- Luke 8:20 (AV) And it was told Him *by certain* which said, Thy mother and Thy brethren stand without, desiring to see Thee.
- Luke 8:20 (NKJV) And it was told Him *by some*, who said, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside, desiring to see You.
- Luke 8:21 (AV) And he answered and said unto them, My mother and My brethren are these which hear the Word of God, and do it.
- Luke 8:21 (NKJV) But He answered and said to them, My mother and My brothers are these who hear the Word of God and do it.
- Matthew 5:38,39 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Ezekiel 44:23 And they shall teach My people the difference between the Holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.
- Numbers 13 Summarized of the reports from the 10 spies.
- Numbers 14:1,2 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night. 2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe Me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- Numbers 14:22,23 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My voice; 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked Me see it:
- Numbers 20:10-12 And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we

- fetch you water out of this rock? 11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also. 12 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed Me not, to sanctify Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Acts 19:18,19 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. 19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Deuteronomy 18:9 (AV) When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- Deuteronomy 18:9 (NKJV) When you come into the land (Born again) which the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Psalms 119:148 Mine eyes prevent the night watches, that I might meditate in Thy Word.
- 1 Timothy 4:8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.
- Deuteronomy 18:10 (AV) There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch,
- Deuteronomy 18:10 (NKJV) There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer,
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of

- Romans 1:25 Who changed the Truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, Who is blessed for ever. Amen.
- Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Referred to Daniel & Joseph Godly prophets who did interpret dreams from God.
- Genesis 40:8 And they said unto him, We have dreamed a dream, and there is no interpreter of it. And Joseph said unto them, Do not interpretations belong to God? tell me them, I pray you.
- Deuteronomy 18:11 (AV) Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Deuteronomy 18:11 (NKJV) or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the sin & fall of mankind. V6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Deuteronomy 18:9 (NKJV) When you come into the land (Born again) which the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations.
- Deuteronomy 18:12 (AV) For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee.
- Deuteronomy 18:12 (NKJV) For all who do these things (Christians) are an abomination to the LORD, and because of these abominations the LORD

- your God drives them out from before you.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- **Leviticus 19 & 20 Referred to God's standards for morality.**
- Deuteronomy 18:13 (AV) Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God.
- Deuteronomy 18:13 (NKJV) You shall be blameless before the LORD your God.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Deuteronomy 18:14 (AV) For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Deuteronomy 18:14 (NKJV) For these nations which you will dispossess listened to soothsayers and diviners; but as for you, the LORD your God has not appointed such for you.
- Joshua 6:21 And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and ass, with the edge of the sword.
- Exodus 30:19,20 For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet thereat: 20 When they go into the tabernacle of the congregation, they shall wash with water, that they die not; or when they come near to the altar to minister, to burn offering made by fire unto the LORD:
- Acts 17:22,23 Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, Ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious. 23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Luke 15 Summarized of the parable of the Prodigal son.
- Luke 15:17-19 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! 18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, 19 And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. Summarized of Salvation by Jesus'.
