

## **This Poor Man Cried – Psalms 34:6**

**Matthew 11:28** Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

**John 14:6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

**Psalms 34:1-22 (AV)**

**Psalms 34:1** «*A Psalm of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed.*» I will bless the LORD at all times: His praise *shall* continually be in my mouth.

**1 Samuel 21:11-14** And the servants of Achish said unto him, *Is not this David the king of the land? did they not sing one to another of him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands?* **12** And David laid up these words in his heart, and was sore afraid of Achish the king of Gath. **13** And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard. **14** Then said Achish unto his servants, Lo, ye see the man is mad: wherefore *then* have ye brought him to me?

**Psalms 34:2** My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear *thereof*, and be glad.

**Job 1:21** And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.

**Job 2:3** And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered My servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst Me against him, to destroy him without cause.

**Psalms 34:3** O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt His Name together.

**2 Chronicles 20:22** And when they (Jehoshaphat & Israel) began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

**Psalms 34:4** I sought the LORD, and He heard me, and delivered

me from all my fears.

**Deuteronomy 4:29** But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find *him*, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.

**James 4:3** Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts.

**Psalms 34:5** They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.

**Matthew 11:29, 30** 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke *is* easy, and my burden is light.

**Matthew 14:29, 30** And He said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

**Psalm 23:4** Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou *art* with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.

**Psalms 34:6** This poor man cried, and the LORD heard *him*, and saved him out of all his troubles.

**Psalms 34:7** The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear Him, and delivereth them.

Pray for God to fulfill this verse to protect us in Jesus' Name.

Summarized of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary for salvation in His Name.

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

**Psalms 34:8** O taste and see that the LORD *is* good: blessed *is* the man *that* trusteth in Him.

**John 10:11** I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd giveth His life for the sheep.

**Psalms 34:9, 10** O fear the LORD, ye His saints: for *there is* no want to them that fear Him. 10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good *thing*.

**James 5:14** Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of

**the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord:**

**Psalms 34:11, 12** Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD. 12 What man *is he that* desireth life, *and* loveth *many* days, that he may see good?

**1 Peter 2:9** But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an Holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him Who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light:

**Psalms 34:13** Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.

**James 1:26** If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion *is* vain.

**1 Timothy 5:13** And withal they (widows) learn *to be* idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.

**Psalms 34:14** Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.

**1 Corinthians 15:33** Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

**Matthew 7:12** Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

**Psalms 34:15** The eyes of the LORD *are* upon the righteous, and His ears *are open* unto their cry.

**Psalms 34:6** This poor man cried, and the LORD heard *him*, and saved him out of all his troubles.

**Psalms 34:16** The face of the LORD *is* against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.

**Genesis 6:5** And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.

**Psalms 34:17** *The righteous* cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.

**Pray for God to fulfill this verse to deliver us from all our troubles in Jesus' Name.**

**Psalms 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.**

**Pray for God to fulfill this verse to help us in Jesus' Name.**

**Psalms 34:19 Many *are* the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.**

**John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.**

**Job 1&2 Job tested & doubly blessed.**

**Job 42:10 And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.**

**Psalms 34:20 He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken. (about Jesus)**

**Psalms 34:21, 22 Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate. 22 The LORD redeemeth the soul of His servants: and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate.**

**"Fear the Lord" list:**

**Exodus 9:30 But as for thee and thy servants, I know that ye will not yet fear the LORD God.**

**Deuteronomy 6:2 That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.**

**Deuteronomy 6:13 Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and serve Him, and shalt swear by His Name.**

**Deuteronomy 6:24 And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as *it is* at this day.**

**Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all His ways, and to love Him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,**

**Deuteronomy 10:20 Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God; Him shalt thou serve, and to Him shalt thou cleave, and swear by His Name.**

**Deuteronomy 14:23** And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which He shall choose to place His Name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

**Deuteronomy 17:19** And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the Words of this Law and these statutes, to do them:

**Deuteronomy 31:12, 13** Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that *is* within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the Words of this Law: **13** And *that* their children, which have not known *any thing*, may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as ye live in the land whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

**Joshua 4:24** That all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it *is* mighty: that ye might fear the LORD your God for ever.

**Joshua 2:9** And she (Rahab) said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

**Joshua 24:14** Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve Him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.

**1 Samuel 12:14** If ye will fear the LORD, and serve Him, and obey His Voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both ye and also the king that reigneth over you continue following the LORD your God:

**1 Samuel 12:24** Only fear the LORD, and serve Him in truth with all your heart: for consider how great *things* He hath done for you.

**Mark 7:6** He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with *their* lips, but their heart is far from me.

**1 Kings 18:12** And it shall come to pass, *as soon as* I am gone

from thee, that the Spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and *so* when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.

**2 Kings 4:1** Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen.

**2 Kings 17:28** Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and taught them how they should fear the LORD.

**2 Kings 17:33** They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence.

**Psalms 15:4** In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but He honoureth them that fear the LORD. *He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not.*

**Psalms 22:23** Ye that fear the LORD, praise Him; all ye the seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and fear Him, all ye the seed of Israel.

**Psalms 27:1** «*A Psalm of David.*» The LORD *is* my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD *is* the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

**Psalms 33:8** Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.

**2 Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad.

**Revelation 20:12** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

**Psalms 34:9** O fear the LORD, ye His saints: for *there is* no want to them that fear Him.

**Psalms 115:11** Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: He *is* their help and their shield.

**Psalms 115:13 He will bless them that fear the LORD, *both* small and great.**

**Psalms 118:4 Let them now that fear the LORD say, that His mercy *endureth* for ever.**

**Psalms 135:20 Bless the LORD, O house of Levi: ye that fear the LORD, bless the LORD.**

**Proverbs 3:7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.**

**Jeremiah 5:24 Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: He reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest.**

**Jeremiah 44:12 And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed, *and* fall in the land of Egypt; they shall *even* be consumed by the sword *and* by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, *and* an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach.**

**Jeremiah 26:19 Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.**

**Hosea 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days.**

**Amos 3:8 The lion hath roared, who will not fear? the Lord GOD hath spoken, who can but prophesy?**

**Jonah 1:9 And he said unto them, I *am* an Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry *land*.**

**Psalms 34:6 This poor man cried, and the LORD heard *him*, and saved him out of all his troubles.**
