

Bow Down Thine Ear, O LORD – Psalms 86:1

Psalms 86:1 «A Prayer of David.» Bow down Thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I *am* poor and needy.

Summarized of salvation by Jesus.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke *is* easy, and My burden is light.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My Voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.

Psalms 86:1-17 (AV) «A Prayer of David.» Bow down Thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I *am* poor and needy. 2 Preserve my soul; for I *am* Holy: O Thou my God, save Thy servant that trusteth in Thee. 3 Be merciful unto me, O Lord: for I cry unto Thee daily. 4 Rejoice the soul of Thy servant: for unto Thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul. 5 For Thou, Lord, *art* good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon Thee. 6 Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications. 7 In the day of my trouble I will call upon Thee: for Thou wilt answer me. 8 Among the gods *there is* none like unto Thee, O Lord; neither *are there any works* like unto Thy works. 9 All nations whom Thou hast made shall come and worship before Thee, O Lord; and shall glorify Thy Name. 10 For Thou *art* great, and doest wondrous things: Thou *art* God alone. 11 Teach me Thy way, O LORD; I will walk in Thy truth: unite my heart to fear Thy Name. 12 I will praise Thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify Thy Name for evermore. 13 For great *is* Thy mercy toward me: and Thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell. 14 O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent *men* have sought after my soul; and have not set Thee before them. 15 But Thou, O Lord, *art* a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth. 16

O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give Thy strength unto Thy servant, and save the son of Thine handmaid. 17 Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see *it*, and be ashamed: because Thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me.

Psalms 86:1 A Prayer of David. Bow down Thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I *am* poor and needy.

Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

Matthew 15:30 And great multitudes came unto Him, having with them *those that were* lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and He healed them:

Mark 6:1-5 And He went out from thence, and came into His own country; and His disciples follow Him. 2 And when the Sabbath day was come, He began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing *Him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *Man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is given unto Him, that even such mighty works are wrought by His hands? 3 Is not this the Carpenter, the Son of Mary, the Brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not His sisters here with us? And they were offended at Him. 4 But Jesus said unto them, A Prophet is not without honour, but in His own country, and among His own kin, and in His own house. 5 And He could there do no mighty work, save that He laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed *them*.

Matthew 19:23 Then said Jesus unto His disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Luke 18:9-14 And He spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: 10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. 11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men *are*, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. 13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as *his* eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his

breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

Psalms 86:2 Preserve my soul; for I *am* Holy: O Thou my God, save Thy servant that trusteth in Thee.

Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

2 Chronicles 7:13 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD.

Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the *son* of Jesse, a man after Mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.

Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Psalms 86:3 Be merciful unto me, O Lord: for I cry unto Thee daily.

Psalms 136 every verse has "for His mercy *endureth* for ever:

Luke 18:1-7 And He spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; 2 Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man: 3 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 4 And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; 5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary

me. 6 And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. 7 And shall not God avenge His own elect, which cry day and night unto Him, though He bear long with them?

Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.

James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts.

Psalms 86:4 Rejoice the soul of Thy servant: for unto Thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul.

Romans 10:9, 10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Psalms 86:5 For Thou, Lord, *art* good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon Thee.

Romans 2:4 Or despisest thou the riches of His goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

Matthew 6:14, 15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

Psalms 86:6 Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.

1 Kings 18:27, 28 And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he *is* a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, *or* peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked. 28 And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them.

1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned

their heart back again.

Psalms 86:7 In the day of my trouble I will call upon Thee: for Thou wilt answer me.

1 Samuel 17:34, 35 And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock: 35 And I went out after him, and smote him, and delivered *it* out of his mouth: and when he arose against me, I caught *him* by his beard, and smote him, and slew him.

1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the Name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, Whom thou hast defied.

Psalms 86:8 Among the gods *there is* none like unto Thee, O Lord; neither *are there any works* like unto Thy works.

Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words, of him shall the Son of Man be ashamed, when He shall come in His Own glory, and *in His Father's*, and of the Holy angels.

1 Samuel 4 Summarized of Eli & sinful sons & the ark taken in battle.

1 Samuel 5:4 And when they arose early on the morrow morning, behold, Dagon *was* fallen upon his face to the ground before the ark of the LORD; and the head of Dagon and both the palms of his hands *were* cut off upon the threshold; only *the stump of Dagon* was left to him.

Daniel 3 & 4 Referred to that Nebuchadnezzar knew God was Almighty, yet he did not follow God.

Zechariah 4:6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This *is* the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

Psalms 86:9 All nations whom Thou hast made shall come and worship before Thee, O Lord; and shall glorify Thy Name.

Romans 14:11 For it is written, *As I live*, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Psalms 86:10 For Thou *art* great, and doest wondrous things:

Thou *art* God alone.

James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Luke Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it *shall be* for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err *therein*.

Psalms 86:11 Teach me Thy way, O LORD; I will walk in Thy truth: unite my heart to fear Thy Name.

Genesis 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

Genesis 2:16, 17 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Psalms 86:12 I will praise Thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify Thy Name for evermore. 13 For great *is* Thy mercy toward me: and Thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.

Strongs #07585 she'owl *sheh-ole'* or sheol *sheh-ole'* AV-grave 31, hell 31, pit 3; 65 1) sheol, underworld, grave, hell, pit 1a) the underworld 1b) the OT designation for the abode of wicked dead 1b1) place of no return 1b2) without praise of God 1b3) wicked sent there for punishment 1b4) righteous not abandoned to it 1b5) of the place of exile (fig) 1b6) of extreme degradation in sin.

Luke 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To

day shalt thou be with me in paradise.

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

1 Peter 3:18-20 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: 19 By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison; 20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

Ephesians 4:8 Wherefore He saith, When He ascended up on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

Strong's #86 hades *hah'-dace* AV-hell 10, grave 1; 11 1) name Hades or Pluto, the god of the lower regions 2) Orcus, the nether world, the realm of the dead 3) later use of this word: the grave, death, hell.

In Biblical Greek it is associated with Orcus, the infernal regions, a dark and dismal place in the very depths of the earth, the common receptacle of disembodied spirits. Usually Hades is just the abode of the wicked, Luke 16:23; Revelation 20:13,14; a very uncomfortable place. TDNT.

Luke 16:22, 23, 26 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that *would come* from thence.

Psalms 86:14 O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent *men* have sought after my soul; and have not set Thee before them.

Job 41:34 He beholdeth all high *things*: he (Leviathan) *is* a king over all the children of pride.

Revelation Referred to many instances of sudden death & destruction as God judges the world.

Revelation 6:15, 16 And the kings of the earth, and the great

men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; 16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Psalms 86:15 But Thou, O Lord, *art* a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.

2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)

Psalms 86:16 O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give Thy strength unto Thy servant, and save the son of Thine handmaid.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Psalms 86:17 Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see *it*, and be ashamed: because Thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me.

Psalms 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Proverbs 3:24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.

Hebrews 13:5 *Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.*
