

Touch Not Mine Anointed - Psalms 105:15

Psalms 105:15 *Saying*, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm.

Referred to recently going through some of David's trials, now we look at his Praises to God for helping him through the trials.

Psalms 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou *art* with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.

Luke 4:29, 30 And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong. 30 But he passing through the midst of them went his way,

Summarized of Jesus' trials at the end of His life yet God protected Him.

Job 1&2 Summarized of Job's trials.

Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.

Job 42:10 And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

Psalms 105:1-45 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon His Name: make known His deeds among the people. 2 Sing unto Him, sing psalms unto Him: talk ye of all His wondrous works. 3 Glory ye in His Holy Name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. 4 Seek the LORD, and His strength: seek His face evermore. 5 Remember His marvellous works that He hath done; His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth; 6 O ye seed of Abraham His servant, ye children of Jacob His chosen. 7 He *is* the LORD our God: His judgments *are* in all the earth. 8 He hath remembered His covenant for ever, the Word *which* He commanded to a thousand generations. 9 Which *covenant* He made with Abraham, and His oath unto Isaac; 10 And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, *and* to Israel for an everlasting covenant: 11 Saying, Unto thee will I give the

land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance: 12 When they were *but* a few men in number; yea, very few, and strangers in it. 13 When they went from one nation to another, from *one* kingdom to another people; 14 He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, He reprov'd kings for their sakes; 15 *Saying*, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm. 16 Moreover He called for a famine upon the land: He brake the whole staff of bread. 17 He sent a man before them, *even* Joseph, *who* was sold for a servant: 18 Whose feet they hurt with fetters: he was laid in iron: 19 Until the time that His Word came: the Word of the LORD tried him. 20 The king sent and loosed him; *even* the ruler of the people, and let him go free. 21 He made him lord of his house, and ruler of all his substance: 22 To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom. 23 Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourn'd in the land of Ham. 24 And He increased his people greatly; and made them stronger than their enemies. 25 He turned their heart to hate His people, to deal subtilly with His servants. 26 He sent Moses His servant; *and* Aaron whom He had chosen. 27 They shew'd His signs among them, and wonders in the land of Ham. 28 He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against His Word. 29 He turned their waters into blood, and slew their fish. 30 Their land brought forth frogs in abundance, in the chambers of their kings. 31 He spake, and there came divers sorts of flies, *and* lice in all their coasts. 32 He gave them hail for rain, *and* flaming fire in their land. 33 He smote their vines also and their fig trees; and brake the trees of their coasts. 34 He spake, and the locusts came, and caterpillers, and that without number, 35 And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground. 36 He smote also all the firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength. 37 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and *there was* not one feeble *person* among their tribes. 38 Egypt was glad when they departed: for the fear of them fell upon them. 39 He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night. 40 *The people* asked, and He brought quails, and satisfied them with the bread of heaven. 41 He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the

dry places *like* a river. 42 For He remembered His Holy Promise, *and* Abraham His servant. 43 And He brought forth His people with joy, *and* His chosen with gladness: 44 And gave them the lands of the heathen: and they inherited the labour of the people; 45 That they might observe His statutes, and keep His laws. Praise ye the LORD.

Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.

Psalms 105:1-7 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon His Name: make known His deeds among the people. 2 Sing unto Him, sing psalms unto Him: talk ye of all His wondrous works. 3 Glory ye in His Holy Name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. 4 Seek the LORD, and His strength: seek His face evermore. 5 Remember His marvellous works that He hath done; His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth; 6 O ye seed of Abraham His servant, ye children of Jacob His chosen. 7 He *is* the LORD our God: His judgments *are* in all the earth.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My Voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.

Matthew 22:12, 13 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. 13 Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast *him* into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Genesis 4:3-5 And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD. 4 And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

Genesis 6:5, 6, 8 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually. 6 And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart. 8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new

tongues;

Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

Psalms 105:8-10 He hath remembered His covenant for ever, the Word *which* He commanded to a thousand generations. 9 Which *covenant* He made with Abraham, and His oath unto Isaac; 10 And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, *and* to Israel *for* an everlasting covenant:

Mark 13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but My Words shall not pass away.

Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,

Psalms 105:11 Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance:

1 Kings 18:39 And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, He is the God; the LORD, He is the God.

Psalms 105:12-14 When they were *but* a few men in number; yea, very few, and strangers in it. 13 When they went from one nation to another, from *one* kingdom to another people; 14 He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, He reproveth kings for their sakes;

Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart *is* in the hand of the LORD, *as* the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

2 Chronicles 20:17 Ye shall not *need* to fight in this *battle*: set yourselves, stand ye *still*, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD *will be* with you.

2 Chronicles 20:21, 22 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for His mercy *endureth* for ever. 22 And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

Judges 7:22 And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the

LORD set every man's sword against his fellow, even throughout all the host: and the host fled to Bethshittah in Zererath, and to the border of Abelmeholah, unto Tabbath. Psalms 105:15, 16 *Saying*, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm. 16 Moreover He called for a famine upon the land: He brake the whole staff of bread.

Genesis 41:29-31 Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt: 30 And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land; 31 And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that famine following; for it *shall be* very grievous.

Psalms 105:17 He sent a man before them, *even* Joseph, *who* was sold for a servant:

Genesis 37:28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty *pieces* of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

Psalms 105:18, 19 Whose feet they hurt with fetters: he was laid in iron: 19 Until the time that His Word came: the Word of the LORD tried him.

Genesis 40 & 41 Joseph interprets dreams in prison & he tells Pharoah.

Psalms 105:20-22 The king sent and loosed him; *even* the ruler of the people, and let him go free. 21 He made him lord of his house, and ruler of all his substance: 22 To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom.

Daniel 6 Summarized of Daniel framed, in the lions den yet not touch Daniel, but enemy died.

Daniel 6:22 My God hath sent His angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before Him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

Psalms 105:23, 24 Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham. 24 And He increased his people greatly; and made them stronger than their enemies.

Exodus 45 Explained that the Israelites lived in the land of Goshen & increased & prospered.

Exodus 1:8-10 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. **9** And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel *are* more and mightier than we: **10** Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out any war, they join also unto our enemies, and fight against us, and *so* get them up out of the land.

Psalms 105:25 He turned their heart to hate His people, to deal subtilly with His servants.

Exodus 7:3 And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

Jeremiah 18 Referred to the potter (God) & the clay (man).

Exodus 1:8 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of *his* good pleasure.

Psalms 105:26 He sent Moses His servant; *and* Aaron whom He had chosen.

Moses was 40 years in Egypt & 40 years in dessert to get Egypt out of Moses.

Psalms 105:27 They shewed His signs among them, and wonders in the land of Ham.

Exodus 16:2, 3 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness: **3** And the children of Israel said unto them, Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, *and* when we did eat bread to the full; for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger.

Psalms 105:28-30 He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against His Word. **29** He turned their waters into blood, and slew their fish. **30** Their land brought forth frogs in abundance, in the chambers of their kings.

Exodus 8:3, 13, 14 And the river shall bring forth frogs abundantly, which shall go up and come into thine house, and into thy bedchamber, and upon thy bed, and into the house of thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thine ovens, and into thy kneadingtroughs: **13** And the LORD did according to

the word of Moses; and the frogs died out of the houses, out of the villages, and out of the fields. 14 And they gathered them together upon heaps: and the land stank.

Psalms 105:31 He spake, and there came divers sorts of flies, and lice in all their coasts.

Exodus 8:18, 19 And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast. 19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This *is* the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Psalms 105:32 He gave them hail for rain, and flaming fire in their land.

Revelation 6:15, 16 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; 16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Psalms 105:33-35 He smote their vines also and their fig trees; and brake the trees of their coasts. 34 He spake, and the locusts came, and caterpillers, and that without number, 35 And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground. 36 He smote also all the firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength.

Exodus 12:30, 31 And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for *there was* not a house where *there was* not one dead. 31 And he called for Moses and Aaron by night, and said, Rise up, and get you forth from among my people, both ye and the children of Israel; and go, serve the LORD, as ye have said.

Psalms 105:37-40 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and *there was* not one feeble *person* among their tribes. 38 Egypt was glad when they departed: for the fear of them fell upon them. 39 He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night. 40 *The people* asked, and He brought quails, and satisfied them with the bread of heaven.

Referred to that Jesus also fed His followers twice.

Psalms 105:41-43 He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places *like* a river. 42 For He remembered His Holy Promise, *and* Abraham His servant. 43 And He brought forth His people with joy, *and* His chosen with gladness:

Egypt was economically destroyed by God when Israel left.

Psalms 105:44 And gave them the lands of the heathen: and they inherited the labour of the people;

Joshua 3:15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,)

Psalms 105:45 That they might observe His statutes, and keep His laws. Praise ye the LORD.

1 Chronicles 16:22 *Saying*, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm.

Psalms 105:15 *Saying*, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm.

1 Chronicles 16:1-6 So they brought the Ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God. 2 And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the Name of the LORD. 3 And he dealt to every one of Israel, both man and woman, to every one a loaf of bread, and a good piece of flesh, and a flagon *of wine*. 4 And he appointed *certain* of the Levites to minister before the Ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel: 5 Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obbedom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals; 6 Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the Ark of the covenant of God.

1 Chronicles 16:7 & on is the same as Psalms 105.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new

tongues;

Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Luke 10:17-20 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. **18** And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. **19** Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. **20** Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Luke 10:17-19 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. **18** And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. **19** Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 10:19 (NKJV) Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by *his* fruit.

Luke 10:20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
