

## **But Shun Profane And Vain Babblings - 2 Timothy 2:16**

**2 Timothy 2:1-26 (AV)**

**2 Timothy 2:1** Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

**Matthew 7** Referred to the parable of the house built on rock or sand.

**2 Timothy 2:2** And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

**Romans 10:17** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

**2 Timothy 2:3** Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

**Matthew 24:13** But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

**2 Timothy 2:4** No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of *this* life; that he may please Him Who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

**Ephesians 6:12** For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

**Matthew 5:16** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

**Matthew 18:18** Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

**2 Timothy 2:5** And if a man also strive for masteries, *yet* is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.

**Matthew 6:20** But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

**1 Corinthians 3:12, 13** Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; **13** Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

**2 Timothy 2:6** The husbandman that laboureth must be first partaker of the fruits.

**1 Timothy 5:18** For the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer *is* worthy of his reward.

**1 Samuel 2:13-15** And the priests' custom with the people was, *that*, when any man offered sacrifice, the priest's servant came, while the flesh was in seething, with a fleshhook of three teeth in his hand; **14** And he struck *it* into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh unto all the Israelites that came thither. **15** Also before they burnt the fat, the priest's servant came, and said to the man that sacrificed, Give flesh to roast for the priest; for he will not have sodden flesh of thee, but raw.

**Exodus 22:29** Thou shalt not delay *to offer* the first of thy ripe fruits, and of thy liquors: the firstborn of thy sons shalt thou give unto Me.

**2 Timothy 2:7** Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things.

**Exodus 20** Referred to the Ten Commandments.

**Isaiah 11:3** And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

**2 Timothy 2:8** Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel:

**Acts 9** Paul's encounter with the Lord Jesus on the road to Damascus.

**2 Timothy 2:9** Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, *even* unto bonds; but the Word of God is not bound.

**Acts 14:19, 20** And there came thither *certain* Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew *him* out of the city, supposing he had been dead. **20**

**Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.**

**2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.**

**Acts 5:18, 29 And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison. 29 Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.**

**2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.**

**2 Corinthians 6:19, 20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.**

**Acts 7:56 (Stephen) And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.**

**2 Timothy 2:11 *It is* a faithful saying: For if we be dead with *Him*, we shall also live with *Him*:**

**Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,**

**2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.**

**2 Timothy 2:12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with *Him*: if we deny *Him*, He also will deny us:**

**Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.**

**2 Timothy 2:13** If we believe not, *yet* He abideth faithful: He cannot deny Himself.

**Mark 9:24** And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help Thou mine unbelief.

**Matthew 14:30** But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

**John 10:11** I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd giveth His life for the sheep.

**2 Timothy 2:14** Of these things put *them* in remembrance, charging *them* before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, *but* to the subverting of the hearers.

**Luke 8:11** the seed is the Word of God. (Miss-used for money)

**Acts 8:9, 10** But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: **10** To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God.

**Genesis 3:2-6** And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: **3** But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. **4** And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: **5** For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. **6** And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

**Summarized of the Judges.** When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them. The punishment got worse each time Israel sinned.

**Ephesians 6:4** And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

**1 Corinthians 15:33** Be not deceived: evil communications

**corrupt good manners.**

**Hebrews 5:12-14** For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which *be* the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. **13** For every one that useth milk *is* unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. **14** But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

**2 Timothy 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth.

Referred to modern false doctrines.

**2 Timothy 2:16 (AV)** But shun profane *and* vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

**2 Timothy 2:16 (NKJV)** But shun profane *and* idle babblings, for they will increase to more ungodliness.

**2 Timothy 2:16 (ESV)** But avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness,

**2 Timothy 2:16 (Message)** Stay clear of pious talk that is only talk. Words are not mere words, you know. If they're not backed by a godly life,

**Acts 5:29** Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

United Church's mission is to save the environment not get people saved.

**2 Timothy 2:17** And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; **18** Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.

**John 6:70** Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?

**Mark 1:11** And there came a Voice from heaven, *saying*, Thou art My Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

**1 Corinthians 8:13** Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

**Acts 11:5-9** I was in the city of Joppa praying: and in a trance I

saw a vision, A certain vessel descend, as it had been a great sheet, let down from heaven by four corners; and it came even to me: 6 Upon the which when I had fastened mine eyes, I considered, and saw fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. 7 And I heard a Voice saying unto me, Arise, Peter; slay and eat. 8 But I said, Not so, Lord: for nothing common or unclean hath at any time entered into my mouth. 9 But the Voice answered me again from heaven, What God hath cleansed, *that* call not thou common.

**2 Timothy 2:19** Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are His. And, Let every one that nameth the Name of Christ depart from iniquity.

**Matthew 24:35** Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Words shall not pass away.

**John 10:14** I am the Good Shepherd, and know My *sheep*, and am known of Mine.

**1 Peter 1:16** Because it is Written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.

**1 John 3:3** And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.

**2 Timothy 2:20** But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

**Jeremiah 18:6** O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay *is* in the potter's hand, so *are* ye in Mine hand, O house of Israel.

**2 Timothy 2:21** If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, *and* prepared unto every good work.

**Malachi 3:3** And he shall sit *as* a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness.

**Hebrews 12:7, 8** If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? **8** But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

**2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth.**

**2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.**

**Proverbs talk about the son to stay away from lustfull women.**

**2 Timothy 2:23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.**

**John 4 Summarized of Jesus talking to the woman at the well who got saved & brought the whole town to Jesus.**

**2 Timothy 2:24, 25 And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all *men*, apt to teach, patient, 25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;**

**Luke 15:17-19 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! 18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, 19 And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants.**

**2 Timothy 2:26 And *that* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.**

**Psalms 91:3 Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.**
