2 Timothy 3:13 (AV) But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

2 Timothy 3:1-17 (AV) & (NKJV)

2 Timothy 3:1 (AV) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

Matthew 24 is a parallel passage to 2 Timothy 3.

2 Timothy 3:1 (NKJV) But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:

2 Timothy 3:2 (AV) For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.

Genesis 18 Referred to that Sodom & Gomorrah were similar.

Exodus 20:Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

2 Timothy 3:2 (NKJV) For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

Romans 1 Referred to Paul's account of mankind's fall to apostacy.

2 Timothy 3:3 (AV) Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

2 Timothy 3:3 (NKJV) unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,

Matthew 6:14, 15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly

Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

2 Timothy 3:4 (AV) Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

2 Timothy 3:4 (NKJV) traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,

1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion *is as* the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness *is as* iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the Word of the LORD, He hath also rejected thee from *being* king.

Romans 14:5, 6 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day *alike*. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind. 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth *it* unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard *it*. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

2 Timothy 3:5 (AV) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

2 Timothy 3:5 (NKJV) having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

2 Timothy 3:6 (AV) For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

2 Timothy 3:6 (NKJV) For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts,

Genesis 3 Referred to Eve deceived.

1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

2 Timothy 3:7 (AV) Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

2 Timothy 3:7 (NKJV) always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

2 Timothy 3:8 (AV) Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

2 Timothy 3:8 (NKJV) Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so

do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith;

Exodus 7:10-12 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent. 11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments. 12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

2 Timothy 3:9 (AV) But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all *men*, as theirs also was.

2 Timothy 3:9 (NKJV) but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.

Exodus 8:7 And the magicians did so with their enchantments, and brought up frogs upon the land of Egypt.

Acts 20:34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.

Acts 27:24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.

2 Timothy 3:11 (AV) Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.

2 Timothy 3:11 (NKJV) persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra — what persecutions I endured. And out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.

Acts 14:19 And there came thither *certain* Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew *him* out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

Acts 17:34 Howbeit certain men (of Athens) clave unto him (Paul), and

believed: among the which was Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

Acts 9:25 Then the disciples took him by night, and let *him* down by the wall in a basket.

John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.

2 Timothy 3:12 (AV) Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

2 Timothy 3:12 (NKJV) Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.

2 Timothy 3:13 (AV) But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

2 Timothy 3:13 (NKJV) But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Mark 16:9-20 Are not in the modern versions of the Bible.

2 Timothy 3:15 (AV) And that from a child thou hast known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 3:15 (NKJV) and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:5 When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

The Gospel of Matthew shows that Jesus Christ was the fulfilment of prophesy from the Old Testament.
