

That They Might Understand The Scriptures – Luke 24:45

Mark 16:6 And he saith unto them, **Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: He is risen; He is not here: behold the place where they laid Him.**

Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,

Summarized of the sufferings of Jesus that He endured to cleanse us from sin.

Luke 16:22-24 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; **23** And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. **24** And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, / say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.

Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud Voice, He said, Father, into Thy hands I commend My Spirit: and having said thus, He gave up the Ghost.

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Luke 24:1-53 (AV)

Luke 24:1 Now upon the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain *others* with them.

John 19:31 The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the Sabbath day, (for that Sabbath day was an High day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be

taken away.

Luke 23:56 And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.

Luke 24:2-4 And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre. **3** And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus. **4** And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:

Hebrews 1:7, 14 And of the angels He saith, Who maketh His angels spirits, and His ministers a flame of fire. **14** Are they (God`s angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Luke 24:5 And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the Living among the dead?

Revelation 22:8, 9 And I John saw these things, and heard *them*. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things. **9** Then saith he unto me, See *thou do it* not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this Book: worship God.

Luke 24:6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how He spake unto you when He was yet in Galilee,

Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Luke 24:7 Saying, The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

John 6:71 He spake of Judas Iscariot *the son* of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.

Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and *to* the people, I find no fault in this Man.

Luke 24:8-11 And they remembered His Words, **9** And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest. **10** It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary *the mother* of James, and other *women that were* with

them, which told these things unto the apostles. 11 And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they believed them not.

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

Luke 24:12 Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

John 20:3-6 Peter therefore went forth, and that other disciple, and came to the sepulchre. 4 So they ran both together: and the other disciple did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre. 5 And he stooping down, *and looking in*, saw the linen clothes lying; yet went he not in. 6 Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and seeth the linen clothes lie,

Luke 24:13-19 And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs. 14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened. 15 And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus Himself drew near, and went with them. 16 But their eyes were holden that they should not know Him. 17 And He said unto them, What manner of communications *are* these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad? 18 And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto Him, Art Thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days? 19 And He said unto them, What things? And they said unto Him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a Prophet mighty in deed and Word before God and all the people:

Summarized of many types of healings Jesus did.

Matthew 7:29 For he taught them as *one* having authority, and not as the scribes.

Luke 24:20-23 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and have crucified Him. 21 But we trusted that it had been He which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these

things were done. 22 Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre; 23 And when they found not His Body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that He was alive.

John 20:12 And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.

Luke 24:24, 25 And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found *it* even so as the women had said: but Him they saw not. 25 Then He said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

Mark 16:14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after He was risen.

Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke Me? and how long will it be ere they believe Me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?

Luke 24:26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into His glory?

Hebrews 4:4, 5 For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. 5 Wherefore when He cometh into the world, He saith, Sacrifice and offering Thou wouldest not, but a Body hast Thou prepared Me:

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, It is finished: and He bowed his head, and gave up the Ghost.

Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He

expounded unto them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

Referred to the sermon on the mount.

Luke 24:28-30 And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and He made as though He would have gone further. 29 But they constrained Him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And He went in to tarry with them. 30 And it came to pass, as He sat at meat with them, He took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake, and gave to them.

Luke 22:19 And He took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is My body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of Me.

Luke 24:31 And their eyes were opened, and they knew Him; and He vanished out of their sight.

2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain *was* full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

Luke 24:32-34 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while He Talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the Scriptures? 33 And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them, 34 Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon.

Luke 22:31-33 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired *to have* you, that he may sift *you* as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. 33 And he said unto Him, Lord, I am ready to go with Thee, both into prison, and to death.

Luke 24:35, 36 And they told what things *were done* in the way, and how He was known of them in breaking of bread. 36 And as they thus spake, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.

Matthew 14:26, 27 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. 27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them,

saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

Luke 24:37-39 But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a Spirit. **38** And He said unto them, Why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts? **39** Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself: handle Me, and see; for a Spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see Me have.

John 20:24, 25 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. **25** The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe.

Luke 24:40-44 And when He had thus spoken, He shewed them *His* hands and *His* feet. **41** And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, He said unto them, Have ye here any meat (food)? **42** And they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb. **43** And He took *it*, and did eat before them. **44** And He said unto them, These *are* the Words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were Written in the Law of Moses, and *in* the Prophets, and *in* the Psalms, concerning Me.

Isaiah prophesied of Jesus.

Psalms 22 David tells of the Sufferings of Jesus.

Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,

John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give *it* you.

Isaiah 6:9, 10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. **10** Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

Romans 10:9, 10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. **10** For with the

heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget *it* not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

Hebrews 5:12-14 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which *be* the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk *is* unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Luke 24:46 And said unto them, Thus it is Written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done.

John 10:17, 18 Therefore doth My Father love Me, because I lay down My life, that I might take it again. 18 No man taketh it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of My Father.

Luke 24:47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His Name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Matthew 3:2 And (John Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

2 Chronicles 7:13, 14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Luke 24:48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on

earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with Power from on High.

Acts 2:1-4 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

Luke 24:50 And He led them out as far as to Bethany, and He lifted up His hands, and blessed them. 51 And it came to pass, while He blessed them, He was parted from them, and carried up into heaven. 52 And they worshipped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

Acts 1:10, 11 And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; 11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, / say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Mark 16:9 Now when *Jesus* was risen early the first *day* of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils.

Luke 24:53 And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
