**Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:**

**Summarized that satan was a deceiver from Genesis 3 to the end of Revelation.**

**Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.**

**Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.**

**Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.**

**John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.**

**Matthew 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* sheep from the goats:**

**Titus 1:1-16 (AV) & (NKJV)**

**Titus 1:1 (AV) Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;**

**Titus 1:1 (NKJV) Paul, a bondservant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which accords with godliness,**

**Acts 9 Referred to Paul's conversion on the road to Damascus.**

**2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's in perils of list.**

**Jeremiah 18:6 O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay *is* in the potter's hand, so *are* ye in Mine hand, O house of Israel.**

**Romans 9:17-24 For the Scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew My power in thee, and that My Name might be declared**

throughout all the earth. 18 Therefore hath He mercy on whom He will *have mercy*, and whom He will He hardeneth. 19 Thou wilt say then unto Me, Why doth He yet find fault? For who hath resisted His will? 20 Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed *it*, Why hast thou made me thus? 21 Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? 22 *What* if God, willing to shew *His* wrath, and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: 23 And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had afore prepared unto glory, 24 Even us, whom He hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Pharaoh was considered the sungod.

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said, Who *is* the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Exodus 8:18, 19 And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast. 19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

**Titus 1:2 (AV) In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;**

**Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,**

**2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, / say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.**

**John 8:44** Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

**Titus 1:3 (AV)** But hath in due times manifested His Word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;

**Titus 1:3 (NKJV)** but has in due time manifested His Word through preaching, which was committed to me according to the commandment of God our Savior;

Summarized of Jesus coming to earth, living to bring people to God, emptying paradise and live in Heaven.

**Matthew 18:20** For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them.

**John 14:26** But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

**Titus 1:4 (AV)** To Titus, *mine* own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

**Titus 1:4 (NKJV)** To Titus, a true son in *our* common faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.

Referred to that God raises up leaders & magnifies them in the sight of the people.

**Joshua 3:7** And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, *so* I will be with thee.

**Acts 16:25-31** And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. 26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed. 27 And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had

been fled. 28 But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here. 29 Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, 30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Referred to that some leaders miss-use the 10% tythe forcing people to pay them from their paycheck.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.

Titus 1:5 (AV) For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee:

Titus 1:5 (NKJV) For this reason I left you in Crete, that you should set in order the things that are lacking, and appoint elders in every city as I commanded you

1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the Voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.

Acts 4:32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any *of them* that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

Acts 5:3, 9 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back *part* of the price of the land? 9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband *are* at the door, and shall carry thee out.

Titus 1:6 (AV) If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.

Titus 1:6 (NKJV) if a man is blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of dissipation or insubordination.

Matthew 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

1 Corinthians 11:27-30 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread,

and drink *this* cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. 28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many *are* weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

**1 Timothy 3:2** A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

**Proverbs 22:6** Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

**Habakkuk 2:15** Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to *him*, and makest *him* drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

**1 Timothy 3:5** (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

**Matthew 7:15** Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

**Exodus 22:18** Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live. (not kill now, but not let live in God's church.)

**Titus 1:7 (AV)** For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;

**Titus 1:7 (NKJV)** For a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money,

**Proverbs 15:1** A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

**Exodus 20:17** Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

**Luke 18:25** For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.

**Luke 18:21, 22** And he said, All these have I kept from my youth up. 22 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and

**distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow Me.**

**Titus 1:8 (AV) But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, Holy, temperate;**

**Titus 1:8 (NKJV) but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, Holy, self-controlled,**

**Leviticus 19:36 Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I *am* the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt.**

**Titus 1:9 (AV) Holding fast the faithful Word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.**

**Titus 1:9 (NKJV) holding fast the faithful Word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict.**

**Acts 15:1, 2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.**

**Acts 15:19, 20 Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.**

**Titus 1:10 (AV) For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:**

**Titus 1:10 (NKJV) For there are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision,**

**Titus 1:11 (AV) Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.**

**Titus 1:11 (NKJV) whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain.**

**1 Samuel 15:18-23 And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and**

said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed. 19 Wherefore then didst thou not obey the Voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD? 20 And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the Voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. 21 But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal. 22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the Voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.

Titus 1:12 (AV) One of themselves, *even* a prophet of their own, said, The Cretians *are* always liars, evil beasts, slow bellies.

Titus 1:12 (NKJV) One of them, a prophet of their own, said, Cretans *are* always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons.

Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 17:26, 27 And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. 27 They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.

Titus 1:13 (AV) This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

**Titus 1:14 (AV) Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.**

**Titus 1:14 (NKJV) not giving heed to Jewish fables and commandments of men who turn from the truth.**

**Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.**

**Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?**

**Revelation 13 Referred to the taking of the mark of the beast.**

**2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?**

**Exodus 1:8, 11 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. 11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.**

**Titus 1:15 (AV) Unto the pure all things *are* pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving *is* nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.**

**Titus 1:15 (NKJV) To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled.**

**2 Timothy 3:13 (AV) But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.**

**2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.**

**1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.**

**Titus 1:16 (AV) They profess that they know God; but in works they deny *him*, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.**

**Titus 1:16 (NKJV) They profess to know God, but in works they deny *Him*, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for**

**every good work.**

**John 10:10** The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
