

Purify Unto Himself A Peculiar People – Titus 2:14

Titus 2:14 (AV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Summarized of Salvation by the shed Blood of Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 1:16 Because it is Written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.

1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Psalms 23:3A He restoreth my soul.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Luke 10:19 (NKJV) Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Titus 2:1-15 (AV) & (NKJV)

Titus 2:1 (AV) But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

Titus 2:1 (NKJV) But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine:

Titus 2:2 (AV) That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

Titus 2:2 (NKJV) that the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in faith, in love, in patience;

Temperate is self control. Agape love not lust. Love the sinner not the sin.

Titus 2:3 (AV) The aged women likewise, that *they be* in behaviour as becometh Holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

Titus 2:3 (NKJV) the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers

of good things;

1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they learn *to be* idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.

Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

Titus 2:14 (AV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Titus 2:4 (AV) That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

Titus 2:4 (NKJV) that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children,

Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife *see* that she reverence *her* husband.

God did not make woman from a hair to rule over Adam nor from a toe-nail for Adam to rule over her. God made woman from a rib near Adam's heart to love her & work together with her.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Titus 2:5 (AV) *To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the Word of God be not blasphemed.

Titus 2:5 (NKJV) *to be* discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the Word of God may not be blasphemed.

Proverbs 31 Referred to the virtuous woman.

Proverbs 7:8-10 Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house, **9** In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night: **10** And, behold, there met him a woman *with* the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.

Ephesians 5 & 6 Referred to Paul saying God's order in the family.

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over

it; but it *shall be* for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err *therein*.

Titus 2:6 (AV) Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

Titus 2:6 (NKJV) Likewise exhort the young men to be sober-minded,

1 Samuel 18:14 And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD *was* with him.

Proverbs has much godly guidance.

Titus 2:7 (AV) In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine *shewing* uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

Titus 2:7 (NKJV) in all things showing yourself *to be* a pattern of good works; in doctrine *showing* integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,

Be a Godly example in all things.

Referred to modern false doctrine.

Luke 8:11 the seed is the Word of God. (not your money)

Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. (not have the god kind of faith)

James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts.

Titus 2:8 (AV) Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

Titus 2:8 (NKJV) sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.

Titus 2:14 (AV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Titus 2:9 (AV) *Exhort* servants to be obedient unto their own masters, *and* to please *them* well in all *things*; not answering again;

Titus 2:9 (NKJV) *Exhort* bondservants to be obedient to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all *things*, not answering back,

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves

do not break through nor steal:

Titus 2:10 (AV) Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.

Titus 2:10 (NKJV) not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.

Titus 2:11 (AV) For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 2:11 (NKJV) For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,

Romans 9:17-24 For the Scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew My power in thee, and that My Name might be declared throughout all the earth. 18 Therefore hath He mercy on whom He will *have mercy*, and whom He will He hardeneth. 19 Thou wilt say then unto me, Why doth He yet find fault? For who hath resisted His will? 20 Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to Him that formed *it*, Why hast thou made me thus? 21 Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? 22 *What* if God, willing to shew *His* wrath, and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: 23 And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had afore prepared unto glory, 24 Even us, whom He hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Colossians 1:14 In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.

Titus 2:14 (AV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us

Titus 2:13 (NKJV) looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

Revelation 19:11 Summarized of

Jesus' return & 1000 year rule unto Armageddon

Titus 2:14 (AV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Titus 2:14 (NKJV) Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for good works.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Titus 2:15 (NKJV) Speak these things, exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no one despise you.

Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
