Proverbs 16:31 The hoary head *is* a crown of glory, *if* it be found in the way of righteousness.

Proverbs 16:31 (AV) The hoary head *is* a crown of glory, *if* it be found in the way of righteousness.

Proverbs 16:31 (NKJV) The silver-haired head *is* a crown of glory, *If* it is found in the way of righteousness.

Leviticus 19:32 (AV) Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, & honour the face of the old man, & fear thy God: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 19:32 (NKJV) You shall rise before the gray headed & honor the presence of an old man, & fear your God: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 18 Referred to God's laws on morality.

Leviticus 19:30 Ye shall keep My Sabbaths, & reverence My Sanctuary: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 19:31 Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I *am* the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, *or* that useth divination, *or* an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things *are* an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so *to do*.

Leviticus 19:32, 33 Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I *am* the

LORD. 33 And if a stranger sojourn with thee in your land, ye shall not vex him.

Matthew 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

Leviticus 19:34-37 *But* the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I *am* the LORD your God. 35 Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure. 36 Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I *am* the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt. 37 Therefore shall ye observe all My statutes, and all My judgments, and do them: I *am* the LORD.

James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth *it* not, to him it is sin.

Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.

Genesis 37:28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty *pieces* of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Proverbs 8:20 I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:

Mark 14:56 For many bare false witness against Him, but their witness agreed not together.

Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and *to* the people, I find no fault in this man.

Proverbs 12:28 In the way of righteousness *is* life; and *in* the pathway *thereof there is* no death.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My Voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.

Matthew 11:18, 19 For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He hath a devil. **19** The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.

John 4 Jesus ministered to the woman at the well to salvation.

John 8 Jesus ministered to the adulterous woman to salvation.

Matthew 10:3 Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James *the son* of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

Luke 19:2 And, behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.

2 Peter 2:21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known *it*, to turn from the Holy Commandment delivered unto them.

Matthew 11:14, 15, 21 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet. **15** Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrhah in the day of judgment, than for that city. **21** Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

Titus 2:1, 2 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine: **2** That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

wine, teachers of good things;**

**1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves

with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;**

**1 Timothy 5:11-13 But the younger widows refuse: for when they
have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry; 12
Having damnation, because they have cast off their first faith.
13 And withal they learn *to be* idle, wandering about from
house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and
busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.**

**Titus 2:4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to
love their husbands, to love their children,**

**Ephesians 5:23, 25, 33 For the husband is the head of the wife,
even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour
of the body. 25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also
loved the church, and gave himself for it; 33 Nevertheless let
every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself;
and the wife *see* that she reverence *her* husband.**

**Titus 2:5 *To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient
to their own husbands, that the Word of God be not
blasphemed.**

**1 Timothy 2:9, 10 In like manner also, that women adorn
themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and
sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly
array; 10 But (which becometh women professing godliness)
with good works.**
