Ephesians 4:8 (AV) Wherefore He saith, When He ascended up on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

Luke 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with Me in paradise.

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Ephesians 5:9 (For the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

Ephesians 4:9 (AV) (Now that He ascended, what is it but that He also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?

Ephesians 4:9 (NKJV) (Now this, He ascended — what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth?

Summarized of Jesus coming to earth to bring people to God.

Ephesians 4:10 (AV) He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Ephesians 4:10 (NKJV) He who descended is also the One Who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud Voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Ephesians 4:11 (AV) And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

Word faith people miss-use this for the 5 Fold ministry.

Referred to many false prophets in the Old Testament.

Deuteronomy 18:20 But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in My Name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.

1 Kings 13 Summarized of the man of God prophesying & the old prophet lying to him to deceive him.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.

Ephesians 4:14 (NKJV) that we should no longer be children,
tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of
doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of
deceitful plotting,
Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye
have need that one teach you again which *be* the first
principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have
need of milk, and not of strong meat.
1 Corinthians 13:11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I
understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became
a man, I put away childish things.
Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is
like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their
fellows,
James 1:6, 8 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he
that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind
and tossed. 8 A double minded man *is* unstable in all his
ways.
Acts 8:9, 11 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which
beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the

Ephesians 4:16 (AV) From Whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.
Ephesians 4:16 (NKJV) from Whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.
Ephesians 4:17 (AV) This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,
Ephesians 4:17 (NKJV) This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind,
1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
Leviticus 19:28 (NKJV) You shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor tattoo any marks on you: I *am* the LORD.
Revelation 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.
Revelation 14:9 Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives *his* mark on his forehead or on his hand,
